

## Appendix 6 Revision of the Labour Force Survey from January 2013

The Statistics Bureau of Japan revised the Labour Force Survey by introducing new questionnaires and enhancing current tables from January 2013 in order to accurately grasp the employment/unemployment situation. ### 1 Revision by changing questionnaires

#### 1.1 Basic questionnaire

##### 1.1.1 Understanding actual condition of non-regular employment

Division(partly): “Ordinary employee” “Indefinite duration contract” & “Limited duration contract”

Note: When calculating “change over the year” during 2013, figures for Major Group of industry(new base) are converted into those of “Dispatching”(old base), and then compared with data of previous year by using cross table of industry and type of employment.

### 2.1 Reorganizing classifications

#### 2.1.2 Reorganizing “weekly hours of work”

- Subdivide “15-34 hours”, ”60 hours or more” (Basic: *old* 10,12,13→ *new* -8,9,3)
- Add “Employed” tabulation for age × weekly hours of work table (Basic: *old* 12→*new* -9)
- Integrate similar tables, delete excessively detailed tables(Basic: *old* 10-2 , 12-2 , 13-2 , 17, 27-2 , 28-2, 29-2, 50, regional 2)

## 2.2 Enhancement in tabulation ,etc.

### 2.2.1 Newly tabulated “Job tenure” (A3)

### 2.2.2 Other enhancement, etc.

- Add person-base labour status × Type of household, Family type of household table (Basic: *new* -6)
- Add “Employed person not at work” in double-income household (Basic: *old* 27 , 28 → *new* -7 , 8 , Detailed :*old* 39,40 → *new* -1,2)
- Add industry and occupation of the previous job in unemployment person by “Reason unable to take up a job” (Detailed: *old* 23 → *new* -4)
- Add age group for “Not in labour force(other)” by marital status, relationship to the head of household, education (Detailed: *old* 2 → *new* -2 )
- Add “3 months or more” and “1 year or more” in duration of unemployment for reducing round-off error (Detailed: *old* 1,23,42 → *new* -1, -4, -4)
- Standardize the order of “Attending school” and “Housekeeping” in accordance with questionnaires(Basic : *old* 2,4 → *new* -2,4)
- Delete inconsistent age group “age 40-54” (Basic: *old* 12,35 → *new* -9, -A )

## 2.3 Change in table number and Excel worksheet posted in e-Stat as statistical tables

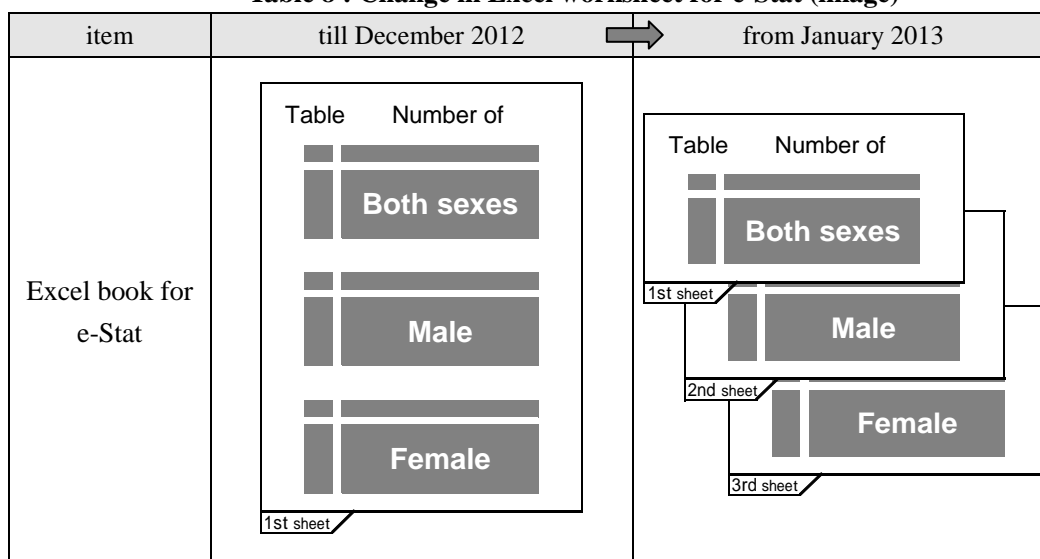
### 2.3.1 Change in table number

- Give number by labour force status in front  
 Basic: I...Population, II...Employed, III...Unemployed, IV Households  
 Detailed: I...Population, II...Employed, III...Unemployed, IV...Not in Labour Force , V...Households
- Name each Excel book beginning the number by type of tabulation: Basic(Whole Japan) beginning “1”, Basic(Regional) beginning “2” , Detailed beginning “4”, ex. Basic(Whole Japan) -3 “102030.xls” )
- Give alphabet instead of number for annual tabulation, except Basic -11-4.

### 2.3.2 Change in Excel worksheet of tables for e-Stat

- Change table layout from current form(repeating stub and head of table) to separated form by attribute(NOT repeating stub and head of table) and introduce freezing panes
- Standardize cell (row and column) number due to independent worksheet by attribute
