First Population Census under the British Administration and limited only to Java island

Under the Dutch Administration, designing the 1st Statistical Year Book (not published yet)

1849
Statistical Year Book first issued under the Dutch Administration

1942-1945

Under the Japan administration, the office's name was changed into Shomubu Chosasitsu Gunseikanbu

24 Sept 1924
The Old BPS was established under the Dutch Administration named Central Kantoor Voor De Statistiek

1930
1st Population Census for the whole region of Indonesia

1945
After Independence, the name changed into General Statistical Research Office of the Republic of Indonesia (KAPPURI), under the Ministry of Agriculture

12 June 1950
The office's name changed into Central Statistics Office (CSO), under the Ministry of Welfare

1 June 1957
the CSO changed into Central Bureau of Statistics

26 September 1997
BPS-Statistics Indonesia

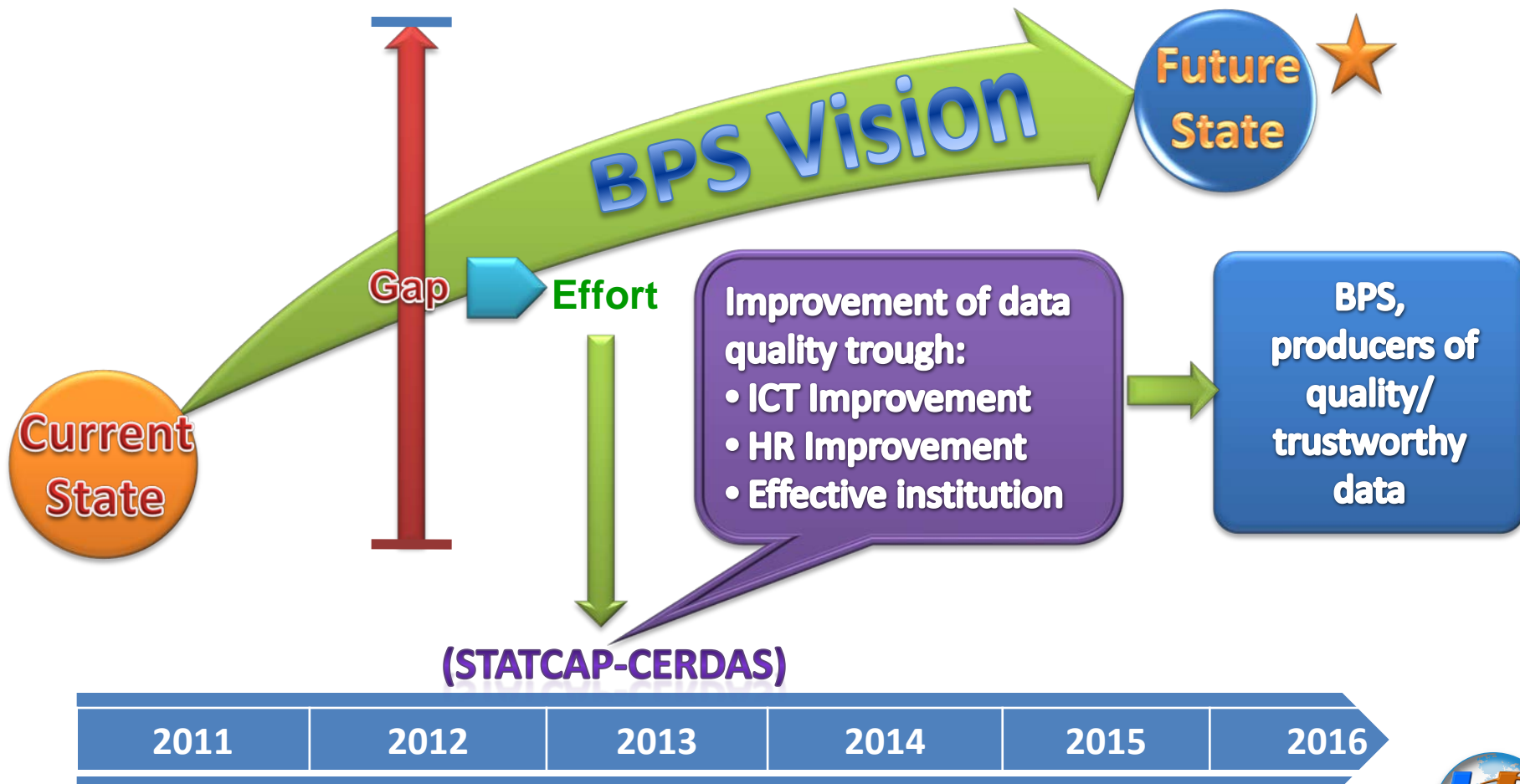

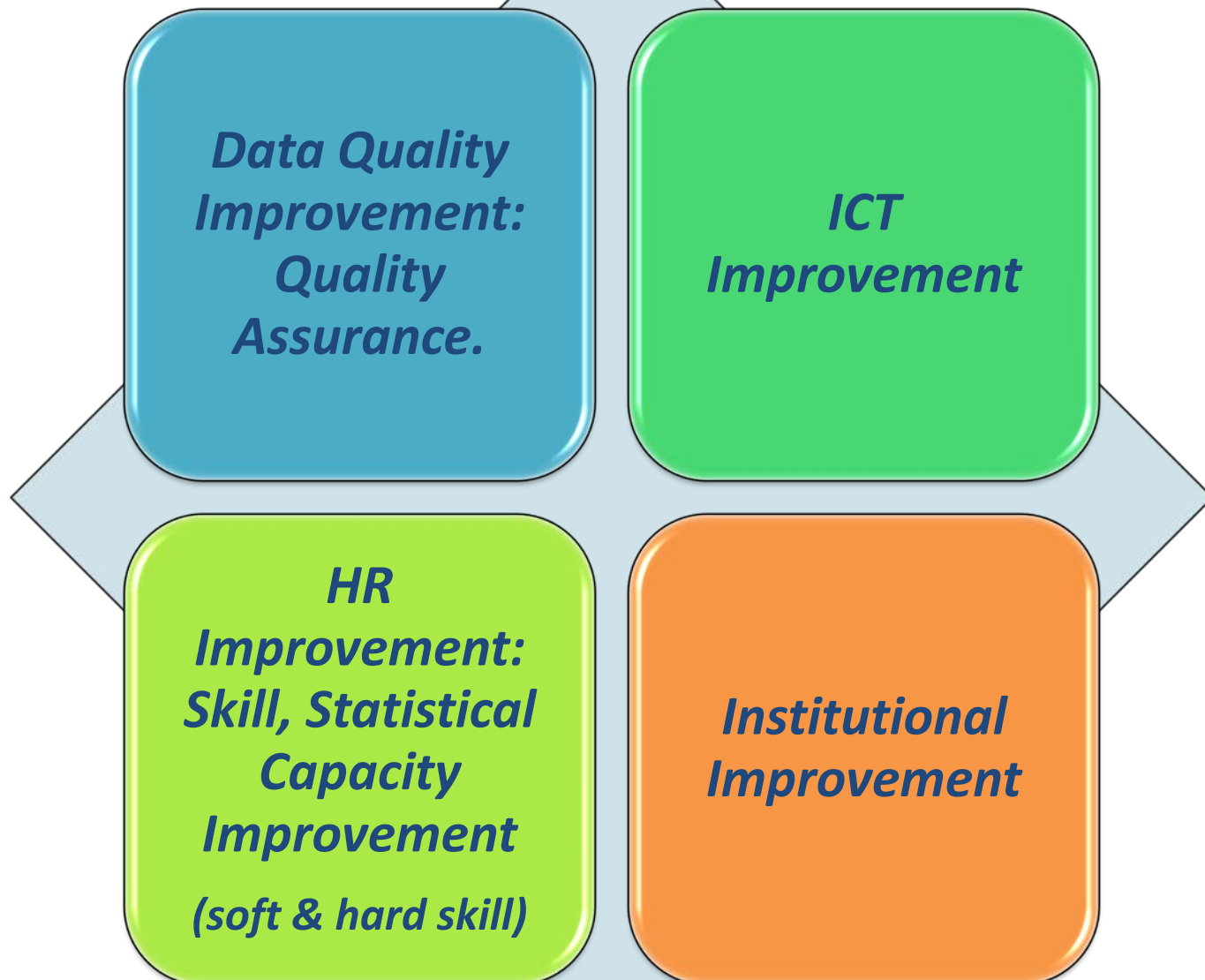

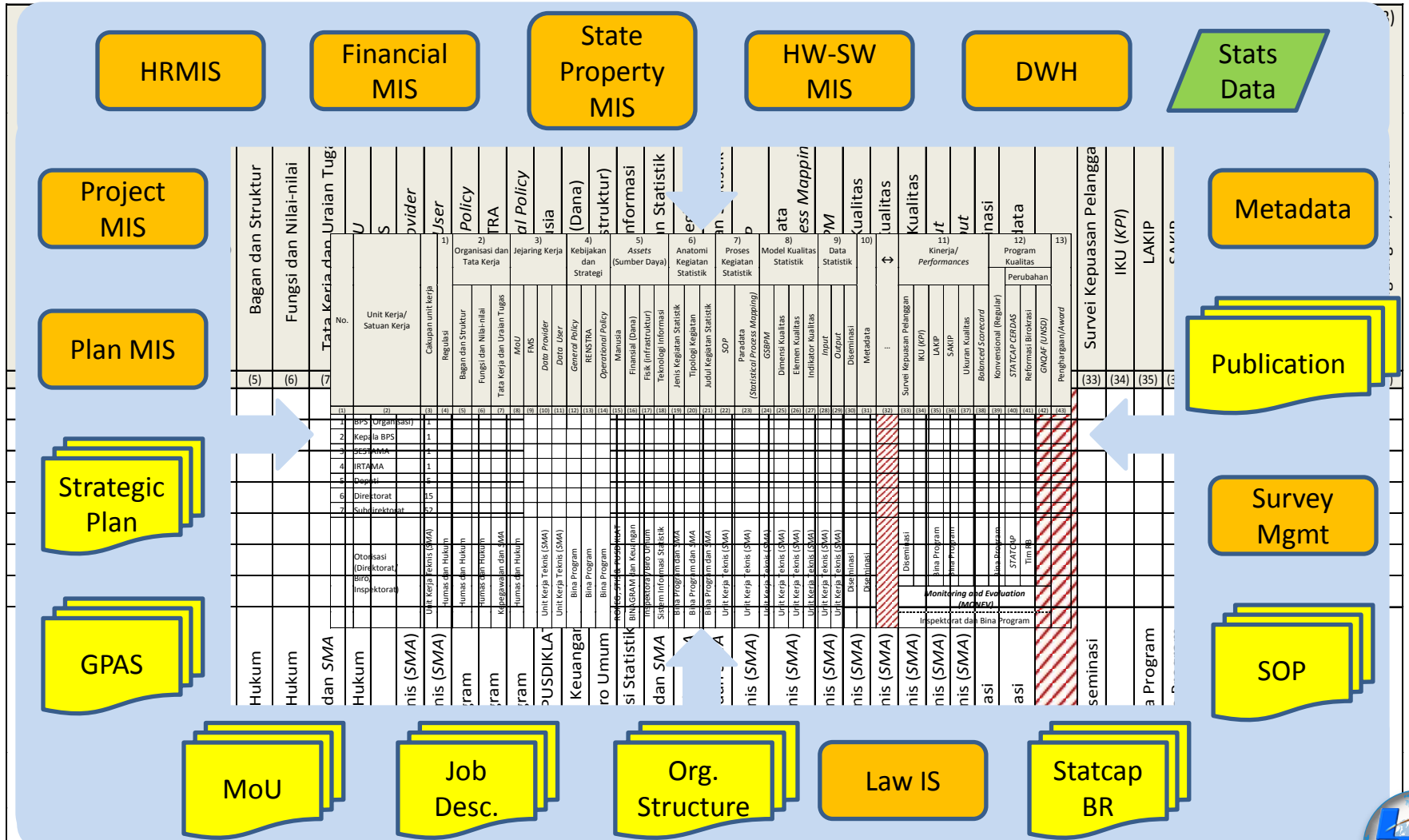
