## Additional CPC Product Detail Environmental Consulting, Waste Management, and Remediation

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### Introduction

The ISIC Revision Concepts paper circulated in early 2003 includes a new grouping for waste management and remediation services. The grouping was proposed in response to the initial questionnaire on issues for consideration in the revision of ISIC and the CPC that was circulated in 2002.

Questionnaire results showed a need for categories dealing with:

- a) Environmental services:
- b) Environmental protection services;
- c) Ecological treatment activities for protecting the environment; and
- d) Categories for treatment of hospital and similar bio-waste.

ISIC currently includes these activities in several industries. First, environmental consulting services are included with ISIC 7421, Architectural and engineering activities and related technical consultancy. Other waste management and remediation services are included in Division 90, Sewage and refuse disposal, sanitation, and similar activities and in Division 37, Recycling.

Similar needs exist for the Central Product Classification (CPC). Environmental services such as consulting, planning, waste management and remediation are currently included in the Central Product Classification (CPC) but lack the detail necessary for meaningful evaluation of a variety of environmental actions. The North American Product Classification System (NAPCS), currently under development by Canada, Mexico, and the United States<sup>2</sup>, includes a detailed listing of environmental services that are offered for consideration when developing new detail in the CPC for the 2007 revision.

All current NAPCS product lists include provisional structures, applied for the convenience of the working groups. The proposal in this paper presents aggregates of the provisional structures, grouped for use in the CPC, which can be used to map all of the detailed NAPCS products. The proposal structure does not necessarily agree with the provisional structures in appendices 1 and 2. Additionally, appendices 1 and 2 present entire lists of products that were identified by producers. These lists include the main products of the industries plus additional products that are also provided by units classified to other industries, such as the transportation of waste. The lists will be unduplicated as more sectors of the economy are covered. The proposals for CPC updates do not include products identified as related products that are already included elsewhere in the CPC. Ultimately, the expectation is that there will be an exhaustive and mutually exclusive list of NAPCS products, covering the outputs of NAICS industries.

The NAPCS initiative has not yet developed products for sewage treatment services. As product detail in that area is developed, it will be offered to UNSD for consideration in

future revisions of the CPC. At this time, the existing products for water treatment in utilities and sewage treatment in sanitation should remain in those divisions. There is not a request to restructure the CPC in order to bring those products together. While the author feels that a demand oriented structure should be applied to the CPC, the existing structure should be maintained to the extent possible until a comprehensive review and replacement of the CPC structure can be undertaken. There is a need for continuity and a significant restructuring of the CPC should only be undertaken with the expectation that the new structure will be appropriate and useful for a considerable number of years.

### Background

The economic size of these environmental activities in the United States is considerable. The 1997 Economic Census provided the following information for the United States:

Environmental Consulting (NAICS 54162) 6725 establishments \$4.8 billion (USD)

Waste Management and Remediation (NAICS 562) 16,368 establishments \$39.3 billion (USD)

The value of environmental consulting, waste management, and remediation services (excluding sewage treatment) in the United States is almost \$45 billion. There are few detailed products in the CPC that can be used to further breakdown that total. The \$45 billion does include the products covered under CPC 942, 9439, and 949, it does not include the products listed under 9431. The \$45 billion also does not include the products of 941, sewage services. Adding sewage services and street cleaning and snow plowing services would add over \$1 billion and 3000 more establishments to the total.

### **Environmental Consulting**

The single CPC product for environmental consulting should be broken out into several new product lines representing some of the major outputs of environmental consulting firms. The NAPCS product list for environmental consulting includes 21 trilateral products. <sup>4</sup> There are also 15 additional US national products. In general, the national level products address further breakdowns based on the target of the environmental consulting work – air, water, soil, noise, etc. <sup>5</sup> The following proposal, although assigned CPC based numbers, would require additional structure modification within CPC 8313. Currently 83131, Environment Consulting Services is a product. An aggregate is recommended for environmental consulting with the proposed new details as the five-digit products.

These breakouts represent aggregations of the major outputs of units that are engaged in environmental consulting. Definitions for each category are:

- **83131 Environmental Assessments** Objective studies undertaken for any one or more of the following purposes: identify whether or not environmental contamination exists at a particular site, and if so the source, nature, and extent of the contamination; assess the risk to public safety and health from environmental contamination associated with a project that is proposed or in place; evaluate the impact on the ecology or economy of environmental changes resulting from human or natural activities.
- **83132 Environmental Audits** Independent assessment of the current status of a party's compliance with applicable environmental requirements or of a party's environmental compliance policies, practices, and controls.
- **83133 Site Remediation Planning Services** Preparation of plans for the abatement of environmental contamination, usually at a specific site, that incorporate such technical or other requirements as may be prescribed by law or regulation.
- **83134 Evaluation of Environmental Studies** Provision of analysis that explains the strengths or weaknesses of an environmental study and provides the basis for alternative judgments. The evaluation of environmental studies may also include an analysis of future responses to environmental regulators.
- **83135** Natural Resource Management Consulting The provision of objective information, advice, or guidance concerning the best practices for ecologically sustainable development and use of: land; forests; bodies of water; gas, oil, and mineral deposits; wildlife populations; and other natural resources.
- **83136 Waste Management Consulting** The provision of objective information, advice, or guidance concerning the best practices for the minimization, transport, handling, disposal, and/or recycling of waste.

**83137 Environmental Policy Development Consulting and Other Environmental Consulting Services** – Advising public or private institutions on the design, development, and implementation of environmental statutes, regulations, standards, or practices; and all other environmental consulting services, not elsewhere classified.

It should be noted that there are a variety of other services provided by environmental consulting establishments that are not environmental consulting products. These include assistance in the environmental licensing and permitting process, litigation support services and expert witness services, training services, etc. that are addressed in other portions of the CPC. The entire list of NAPCS products identified as outputs of environmental consulting establishments is included in appendix 1.

### **Waste Management and Remediation Services**

The nine detailed products in division 94 of the CPC are broken down by NAPCS into over 100 more detailed products. There are two dimensions that are included in those breakouts – location of services and type of material being addressed. This is most likely too much detail for the CPC. Additional detail was collected in the test of these products in the 2002 Economic Census in the United States. The proposal included here attempts to retain the basics of the NAPCS product lists while aggregating to a level more appropriate to the CPC. The entire list of NAPCS products for Waste Management and Remediation Services is included in appendix 2.

A review of the CPC products in division 94 raised some immediate observations and recommendations for clarification even if no additional detail is included. Products in 942, in definitions and in the index items of the CPC, reference the collection and transportation of various wastes. The CPC should address the final outputs of producing units and avoid the trap of including intermediate products – products that are produced and consumed in the provision of other products – within the product definitions. The services provided under the collection products are collection that has a produced and consumed transportation component. The references to collection and transportation may raise confusion regarding units that are simply transporting waste that has been collected by other units. The separate transportation of waste would be classified in Divisions 64 to 66 depending on the mode of transportation. Collection of waste should be emphasized in Division 94 and appropriate cross-references or exclusions for the separate transportation of waste should be added to the CPC text.

Another observation is that remediation activities are not clearly identified in the CPC. There were a number of improvements in the wording for products in this area with CPC Ver.1.1. Subclass 94221 was changed to more clearly identify the collection products that were to be included. The only descriptive language in Version 1.0 was "This subclass includes oil spill fighting services". That product was moved to subclass 94222 in version 1.1 and 94221 now includes the following descriptive text, "This subclass includes: collection of organic solvents, tires, batteries, nuclear wastes, biohazardous materials, pesticides, herbicides, PCBs, dead stock, etc." Similar clarifications should be

made to specifically include remediation activities for contaminated sites in the CPC even if no additional product detail is added.

Finally, products that are neither collection nor treatment or disposal, such as the services of waste transfer stations or materials recovery facilities, are not clearly identified in the CPC. The ISIC Rev. 3 index includes materials recovery facilities, hazardous waste transfer stations, and nonhazardous waste transfer stations in 9000. There are no corresponding products in the CPC – they could either be included in 942 or in 949 with Other environmental protection services, n.e.c. Once again, regardless of the addition of detail, classification of these products should be clearly indicated in future versions of the CPC.

The NAPCS based proposal for changes to the products in Division 94 attempts to account for the issues noted above while simultaneously adding important structure and detailed product improvements.<sup>6</sup> As noted above, no immediate changes for the products of CPC 941 and CPC 943 are being proposed at this time. New numbering has been applied in this proposal in order to avoid using the same numbers for significantly different products in sequential versions of the CPC.

These breakouts represent aggregations of the major outputs of units engaged in providing waste management and remediation services. Definitions of each category are:

**94411 Nonhazardous Waste Collection Services, Residential** – Collection of nonhazardous waste, garbage, rubbish, refuse, trash, and commingled materials from residential dwellings. Examples of the services include curbside collection, back door collection, or automated collection on a flexible or regular schedule.

### 94412 Nonhazardous Recyclable Material Collection Services, Residential –

Collection of nonhazardous recyclable materials, such as cardboard, paper, plastic, glass, aluminum, steel and organic yard waste from residential dwellings. The recyclable materials may be presorted or commingled. Examples of the services include curbside collection, back door collection, or automated collection on a flexible or regular schedule.

**94413 Nonhazardous Waste Collection Services, Nonresidential** – Collection of nonhazardous waste, garbage, rubbish, refuse, trash, and commingled materials from nonresidential locations. The collection may be on a regular or flexible schedule.

**94414** Nonhazardous Recyclable Material Collection Services, Nonresidential – Collection of nonhazardous recyclable materials, such as cardboard, paper, plastic, glass, aluminum, steel, and other recyclable materials from nonresidential locations. The recyclable materials may be presorted or commingled. Collection services may be on a

regular or flexible schedule.

- **94421 Nonhazardous Waste and Recyclable Materials Consolidation, Storage, and Preparation Services, including Transfer Facility Services** Services involving the consolidation, temporary storage, and preparation of nonhazardous waste and recyclable materials. Services include consolidation and preparation of nonhazardous waste for transportation to an appropriate facility that processes waste. Also includes recovery of recyclable materials and preparation, such as bailing, cleaning, sorting, volume reduction, and similar preparation and consolidation of recyclable materials, for transport.
- **94422 Landfill (except Sanitary Landfill) Services, Nonhazardous Waste** Disposal of nonhazardous waste on or in a landfill (except sanitary landfill).
- **94423 Sanitary Landfill Services, Nonhazardous Waste** Disposal of nonhazardous waste on or in a sanitary landfill which meets the sanitary landfill criteria specified by legislation or regulation.
- **94424 Incineration of Nonhazardous Waste** Incineration of nonhazardous waste in a facility that meets legal standard and requirements for incineration of nonhazardous wastes.
- **94429 Other Nonhazardous Waste Disposal Services** Other nonhazardous waste disposal services, including maintenance and closure of landfills and similar activities.
- **94431 Hazardous Waste Collection Services, Residential** Collection of hazardous waste including materials that may be hazardous to human health or the environment that require special handling techniques specified by legislation or regulation.
- **94432 Hazardous Waste Collection Services, Medical and Other Biohazardous Wastes** Collection of pathological wastes (e.g., anatomical wastes; non-anatomical wastes; sharps wastes, such as needles and scalpels) and other biological-infectious wastes from hospitals, medical practices, dental practices, medical laboratories, and other non-residential locations.
- 94433 Hazardous Waste Collection Services, Nonresidential (except Medical and Other Biohazardous Wastes) Collection of hazardous wastes (except medical and biological) that may be hazardous to human health or the environment that require special handling techniques specified by legislation or regulation.
- **94441 Hazardous Waste Consolidation, Storage, and Preparation Services, including Hazardous Waste Transfer Facility Services** Services involving the consolidation, temporary storage, and preparation of hazardous waste. Services include consolidation and preparation of hazardous waste for transportation to an appropriate facility that processes waste. This product also includes the services of drop off centers, transfer stations, and container stations.

- **94442 Hazardous Waste Treatment Services** Treatment to reduce, eliminate, or transform hazardous waste. Processes include biological, chemical, and/or physical procedures or incineration. These procedures may lead to a disposable residual or result in the recovery of recyclable material.
- **94443 Hazardous Waste Disposal Services** Disposal services for hazardous waste at a facility that meets legal standards for the disposal of hazardous waste. Examples include disposal of hazardous waste at approved controlled containment facilities, landfills, and other methods approved for the disposal of hazardous wastes.
- **94449 Other Hazardous Waste Management Services** Other services related to the management of hazardous waste including the operation, maintenance, closure of hazardous waste disposal facilities, and other hazardous waste management services, n.e.c.
- **94511 Site Remediation Clean-Up Services, Air** Implementation of an approved plan for the remediation of air on a contaminated site meeting requirements specified by legislation or regulation.
- **94512 Site Remediation Clean-Up Services, Water** Implementation of an approved plan for the remediation of water on a contaminated site meeting requirements specified by legislation or regulation.
- **94513 Site Remediation Clean-up Services, Soil** Implementation of an approved plan for the remediation of soil on a contaminated site meeting requirements specified by legislation or regulation.
- **94519 Site Remediation Containment, Control, and Monitoring Services and Other Site Remediation Services, n.e.c.** operations to prevent additional or wider contamination on the site or prevent movement of uncontrolled contaminates from the site; monitoring the site to determine the effectiveness of remediation activities, controlling access to the contaminated site, and other site remediation services, n.e.c.
- **94520 Building Remediation Services** Development and implementation of a remediation plan that removes, destroys, contains, or otherwise reduces contaminants, such as asbestos, lead, radon, or other contaminates, in a building.
- **94590 Other Remediation Services, n.e.c.** Other remediation services, such as environmental emergency response services and other remediation services, n.e.c.

There is considerable overlap with the products of environmental consulting in the area of waste management and remediation. There are also a number of other products produced by waste management and remediation units. These include decommissioning services, sales of recyclable materials, brokerage services, separate market provided transportation services, and other products covered elsewhere in the CPC.

### Conclusion

The NAPCS product development initiative provides a valuable list of products that are offered for consideration when addressing a revision of the current CPC products for environmental consulting, waste management services, and remediation services. Subcommittees in Canada, Mexico, and the United States developed the products jointly with considerable input from businesses, associations, and academics that provide or study these services.

There is an inherent difficulty in making a distinction between hazardous and nonhazardous waste. Various nations have different regulations and laws relating to hazardous wastes. The United States, Canada, and Mexico were able to reach consensus on the definitions of hazardous and nonhazardous wastes with the help of industry experts and a review of relevant legislation in each country. The proposal included in this paper minimizes the problem by defining hazardous and nonhazardous wastes by example and reference to applicable laws and regulations rather than strict content (with the exception of medical and biohazardous wastes which is included separately under hazardous waste because of the interest expressed in the ISIC concepts paper responses).

This proposal represents a more appropriate level of detail for environmental services in the product classification acknowledging the growing interest in this subject throughout the world. Any recommendations or alternatives to this proposal are welcomed.


