- The consumer price index for Japan in April 2018 was 100.9 (2015=100), up 0.6 % over the year before seasonal adjustment, and down 0.4 % from the previous month on a seasonally adjusted basis.

- As of May 1, 2018 (Provisional estimates)
- <Total Population>
  - The total population was 126.49 million, a decrease of 0.23 million (0.19 percent) from the previous year.
- As of December 1, 2017 (Final estimates)
- <Total Population>
  - The total population was 126,695 thousand, a decrease of 223 thousand (0.18 percent) from the previous year.
  - The population under 15 years old was 15,563 thousand, a decrease of 182 thousand (1.15 percent) from the previous year.
  - The population aged 15 to 64 was 75,916 thousand, a decrease of 585 thousand (0.77 percent) from the previous year.
  - The population aged 65 and over was 35,215 thousand, an increase of 544 thousand (1.57 percent) from the previous year.
  - <Japanese Population>
  - Japanese population was 124,576 thousand, a decrease of 379 thousand (0.30 percent) from the previous year.

- \*Unincorporated Enterprise Survey (Trend survey) (January to March 2018)
  - The sales per establishment for January-March 2018 increased by 11.0 % in "Wholesale and retail trade" and 8.6 % in "Accommodations and food services", decreased by 13.7 % in "Manufacturing" and 0.4 % in "Services", respectively over the previous year (corresponding period).
  - The net operating profit per establishment for January-March 2018 increased by 43.6 % in "Wholesale and retail trade", 4.3 % in "Accommodations and food services", 1.6 % in "Services", decreased by 16.7 % in "Manufacturing", respectively over the previous year (corresponding period).

- The consumer price index for Ku-area of Tokyo in May 2018 (preliminary) was 100.5 (2015=100), up 0.4% over the year before seasonal adjustment, and the same level as the previous month on a seasonally adjusted basis.

- \* "Labour Force Survey (Basic Tabulation)" (April 2018)
  - The number of employed persons in April 2018 was 66.71 million, an increase of 1.71 million or 2.6 % from the previous year.
  - The number of unemployed persons in April 2018 was 1.80 million, a decrease of 170 thousand or 8.6 % from the previous year.
  - The unemployment rate, seasonally adjusted, was 2.5 %.

- \* "Monthly Report on Internal Migration in Japan" (April 2018)
  - The number of internal migrants (All nationalities) was 761,821, an increase of 12,043 (1.6 %) from the previous year.
  - The number of inter-prefectural migrants (All nationalities) was 411,276, an increase of 7,227 (1.8 %) from the previous year.
  - The number of intra-prefectural migrants (All nationalities) was 350,545, an increase of 4,816 (1.4 %) from the previous year.
  - The number of internal migrants (Japanese) was 712,159, an increase of 10,101 (1.4 %) from the previous year.
  - The number of inter-prefectural migrants (Japanese) was 384,709, an increase of 6,638 (1.8 %) from the previous year.
  - The number of intra-prefectural migrants (Japanese) was 327,450, an increase of 3,463 (1.1 %) from the previous year.

- \* "Survey of Household Economy" (April 2018) (Two- or- more-person households)
  - Change over the year of Monthly Expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet
- <Average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet>
  - Average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet was 11,688 yen (up 22.2 % in nominal terms).

- <Main Items contributed to the change of Average Expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet >
  - Travel-related costs: up 41.2 % in nominal terms
  - Clothing, footwear: up 26.1 % in nominal terms
  - Insurance: up 28.6 % in nominal terms
  - Automotive-related products: up 56.8 % in nominal terms

- Expenditures for Two-or-more-person Households

The average of monthly consumption expenditures per household for April 2018 was 294,439 yen, down \*\*0.5 % in nominal terms and down \*\*1.3 % in real terms from the previous year.

- Income and Expenditures for Workers' Households

The average of monthly income per household stood at 495,370 yen, up \*\*0.6 % in nominal terms but down \*\*0.2 % in real terms from the previous year.

The average of consumption expenditures per household was 334,967 yen, up \*\*1.5 % in nominal terms and up \*\*0.7 % in real terms from the previous year.
