<News Highlights>

*** The 31st Population Census Conference to be held in Tokyo, Japan**

The Statistics Bureau of Japan (SBJ) and the Association of National Census and Statistics Directors of America, Asia and the Pacific (ANCSDAAP) will co-host the 31st Population Census Conference in Tokyo from November 29 to December 1, 2022.

The Population Census Conference started in 1971, advocated by the East-West Center (EWC) in Hawaii, USA, and the Conference has been conducted approximately once every two years. The purpose of the conference is to share experience and methods for the collection and use of population census and related statistical information among the countries of America, Asia and the Pacific.

The 31st conference will be the first in-person conference after the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, and held under the following theme: "The Impact of COVID-19 on the 2020 Round of Censuses and How to Overcome the Ensuing Challenges".

“Population Estimates” (Final estimates, Japan, May 1, 2022)

[Total Population]

- The total population was 125,072 thousand, a decrease of 704 thousand (0.56%) from the previous year.
- The population under 15 years old was 14,623 thousand, a decrease of 266 thousand (1.79%) from the previous year.
- The population aged 15 to 64 was 74,200 thousand, a decrease of 533 thousand (0.71%) from the previous year.

- The population aged 65 and over was 36,249 thousand, an increase of 95 thousand (0.26%) from the previous year.

[Japanese Population]

- The Japanese population was 122,325 thousand, a decrease of 672 thousand (0.55%) from the previous year.

“Population Estimates” (Provisional estimates, Japan, October 1, 2022)

[Total Population]

- The total population was 124.83 million, a decrease of 0.67 million (0.53%) from the previous year.

“Consumer Price Index” (2020-base, Japan, September 2022)

- The consumer price index for Japan was 103.1 (2020=100), up 3.0% over the year before seasonal adjustment, and up 0.3% from the previous month on a seasonally adjusted basis.

“Monthly Report on Internal Migration” (Japan, September 2022)

[All nationalities]

- The number of internal migrants was 358,962, an increase of 12,296 (3.5%) from the previous year.
- The number of inter-prefectural migrants was 161,414, an increase of 8,441 (5.5%) from the previous year.
- The number of intra-prefectural migrants was 197,548, an increase of 3,855 (2.0%) from the previous year.

[Japanese]

- The number of internal migrants was 318,047, an increase of 1,565 (0.5%) from the previous year.
- The number of inter-prefectural migrants was 139,460, an increase of 2,949 (2.2%) from the previous year.
- The number of intra-prefectural migrants was 178,587, a decrease of 1,384 (0.8%) from the previous year.

“Labour Force Survey” (Basic Tabulation, Japan, September 2022)

- The number of employed persons was 67.66 million, an increase of 0.40 million from the previous year.
- The number of unemployed persons was 1.87 million, a decrease of 0.07 million from the previous year.
- The unemployment rate, seasonally adjusted, was 2.6%.

“Consumer Price Index” (Preliminary, 2020-base, Ku-area of Tokyo, October 2022)

- The consumer price index for Ku-area of Tokyo (preliminary) was 103.4 (2020=100), up 3.5% over the year before seasonal adjustment, and up 0.5% from the previous month on a seasonally adjusted basis.

“Monthly Survey on Service Industries” (Preliminary, Japan, August 2022)

- Monthly sales: 30.9 trillion yen, up 7.2% over the year.
- Number of persons working at the location of establishment: 29.40 million persons, up 0.9% over the year.

“Family Income and Expenditure Survey” (Two-or-more-person Households, Japan, September 2022)

[Expenditures for Two-or-more-person Households]

- The average of monthly consumption expenditures per household was 280,999 yen, up 5.9% in nominal terms and up 2.3% in real terms from the previous year.

[Income and Expenditures for Workers' Households]

- The average of monthly income per household stood at 499,438 yen, up 3.7% in nominal terms and up 0.2% in real terms from the previous year.
- The average of consumption expenditures per household was 313,989 yen, up 6.2% in nominal terms and up 2.6% in real terms from the previous year.

“Survey of Household Economy” (Two-or-more-person Households, Japan, September 2022)

- Change over the year of monthly expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet
- [Average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet]
- Average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet was 20,058 yen (up 11.9% in nominal terms).

[Main items contributed to the change of average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet]

- Travel-related costs: up 150.0% in nominal terms
- Tickets: up 101.8% in nominal terms
- Food: up 2.9% in nominal terms
- Clothing, footwear: up 4.6% in nominal terms

“Labour Force Survey” (Detailed Tabulation, Japan, Quarterly Average Results Jul.-Sep. 2022)

- The number of the regular employee was 35.86 million, a decrease of 0.21 million from the previous year.
- The number of the non-regular employee was 21.20 million, an increase of 0.49 million from the previous year.
