1.3.2 Place of Work or Schooling of Provincial Population

Tables 1.2, 1.3 and 1.4 show the percentage of the population aged 10 and over by place of work or schooling for each province. According to Table 1.2, the proportion of the persons direct to and returned from another district shows the highest (13.8%) in Phnom Penh, the second highest (5.6%) in Kandal, and the third highest (3.9%) in

Kampong Speu, while it records the lowest (0.4%) in Preah Vihear. The province exceeding the national average 3.0 percent is Kep beside three provinces described above. While, the provinces under 1.00 percent amounts seven beside Preah Vihear.

On the other hand, the proportion of the persons whose place of work or schooling are at

home, or non commuters presents the highest (5.5%) in Phnom Penh, the second highest

(4.1%) in Preah Shihanouk and the third highest (2.9%) in Koh Kong, while the lowest (0.95%) in Svay Rieng.

For the percentage of the persons by place of work, similar pattern in the ranking of the proportion of the persons direct to and returned from another district is recognized.

However, the proportion is higher than that by place of work or schooling for each province

(Table 1.3).

For the percentage of the persons by place of schooling, different pattern in the ranking of the proportion of the persons direct to and returned from another district is found. Although the proportion shows the highest (8.85%) is Phnom Penh, the second highest (3.11 %) is presented for Pailin, the third highest (2.13%) for Kandal. Excluding those provinces there is no province indicating the proportion exceeding national average (1.82%). This suggests that commuting of students across a district boundary is less significant in Cambodia (Table 1.4).
