## International Comparison of Preliminary Results, NEC2018

### International Comparison of Number of Establishments

<b>Nepal:</b>	<b>0.9 million establishments</b>
<b>Japan:</b>	<b>5.8</b>
<b>Indonesia:</b>	<b>26.7</b>
<b>Sri Lanka:</b>	<b>1.0</b>
<b>Cambodia:</b>	<b>0.5</b>

Among these five countries, Nepal has relatively fewer establishments.

## International Comparison of Preliminary Results, NEC2018

### International Comparison of Number of Establishments per 1,000 Persons

<b>Nepal :</b>	<b>31.6 establishments per 1,000 persons</b>
<b>Japan:</b>	<b>45.4</b>
<b>Indonesia:</b>	<b>104.6</b>
<b>Sri Lanka:</b>	<b>50.3</b>
<b>Cambodia:</b>	<b>34.6</b>

Among these five countries,  
Nepal has relatively fewer establishments for its population size.

This is probably due to geographical disadvantage  
such as upcountry and mountainous.

## International Comparison of Preliminary Results, NEC2018

### International Comparison of Number of Establishments per km<sup>2</sup>

<b>Nepal:</b>	<b>6.3 establishments per km<sup>2</sup></b>
<b>Japan:</b>	<b>15.3</b>
<b>Indonesia:</b>	<b>13.9</b>
<b>Sri Lanka:</b>	<b>15.5</b>
<b>Cambodia:</b>	<b>2.8</b>

Among these five countries, the establishment density of Nepal is relatively lower for its area size. This is probably due to geographical disadvantage such as upcountry and mountainous.

## International Comparison of Preliminary Results, NEC2018

### International Comparison of Sex Ratio of Number of Persons Engaged

<b>Nepal:</b>	<b>150.0 (males per 100 females)</b>
<b>Japan:</b>	<b>125.7</b>
<b>Indonesia:</b>	<b>183.9</b>
<b>Sri Lanka:</b>	<b>154.0</b>
<b>Cambodia:</b>	<b>63.4</b>

Among these five countries, although the sex ratio in Nepal seems average, it is not always fair in respect to gender equality. The higher ratios may be due to the fact that large proportion of female may be involved in agricultural occupation or households in Nepal.

## International Comparison of Preliminary Results, NEC2018

### International Comparison of Number of Persons Engaged per Establishment

<b>Nepal:</b>	<b>3.7</b> persons per establishment
<b>Japan:</b>	<b>9.9</b>
<b>Indonesia:</b>	<b>2.6</b>
<b>Sri Lanka:</b>	<b>2.8</b>
<b>Cambodia:</b>	<b>3.3</b>

Among these five countries,  
Nepal has relatively more persons engaged per establishment.  
This is probably due to fewer street businesses in Nepal.

## Preliminary Results by District, NEC2018

### Number of Establishments by District (top five districts)

<b>1. Kathmandu:</b>	<b>123,994</b> establishments
<b>2. Jhapa:</b>	<b>38,741</b>
<b>3. Rupandehi:</b>	<b>38,415</b>
<b>4. Morang:</b>	<b>35,237</b>
<b>5. Sunsari:</b>	<b>31,486</b>

Kathmandu has a gigantic size of the number of establishments,  
and occupies 13.4% to the total number of Nepal.  
Other four districts are located in plain areas.

## Preliminary Results by District, NEC2018

**Establishment Density by District** (top five districts)

- 1. Kathmandu: 313.9 establishments/km<sup>2</sup>**
- 2. Bhaktapur: 164.9**
- 3. Lalitpur: 70.2**
- 4. Rupandehi: 28.2**
- 5. Sunsari: 25.0**

The first three districts are located in the Kathmandu Valley and the remaining last two districts lies in the southern plain areas of the country.

## Preliminary Results by District, NEC2018

**Number of Persons Engaged by District** (top five districts)

- 1. Kathmandu: 575,003 persons**
- 2. Rupandehi: 163,045**
- 3. Morang: 143,386**
- 4. Lalitpur: 139,686**
- 5. Jhapa: 129,180**

Kathmandu occupies 16.9% to the total number of Nepal. These five districts occupies more than one third of the total number of persons engaged in Nepal.

## Preliminary Results by District, NEC2018

### Sex Ratio of Number of Persons Engaged by District (top five districts)

<b>1. Bara:</b>	<b>301.9</b>	(males per 100 females)
<b>2. Rautahat:</b>	<b>300.5</b>	
<b>3. Parsa:</b>	<b>281.5</b>	
<b>4. Kapilbastu:</b>	<b>268.5</b>	
<b>5. Mahottari:</b>	<b>264.4</b>	

These five districts are located in the south side of the country where is in plain areas.

The higher ratios may be due to the fact that large proportion of female may be involved in agricultural occupation in these districts.

<b>1. Lalitpur:</b>	<b>5.2</b>
<b>2. Manang:</b>	<b>4.9</b>
<b>3. Kathmandu:</b>	<b>4.6</b>
<b>4. Lamjung:</b>	<b>4.6</b>
<b>5. Sarlahi:</b>	<b>4.6</b>

In Lalitpur and Kathmandu, many enterprises headquarter there. In Sarlahi, there are some famous sugar mill factories which are employing thousands of people including farmers.

## Preliminary Results by Municipality, NEC2018

Number of Establishments by City/Municipality (top five municipalities)

**Kathmandu: 79,607 establishments**

**Pokhara: 28,222**

**Lalitpur: 18,373**

**Bharatpur: 17,066**

**Biratnagar: 10,383**

(Butwal: 10,141)

Kathmandu Metropolitan City has a gigantic size of the number of establishments, and occupies 8.6% to the total number of Nepal.
