## [Explanation of Map V]

Map V shows the rate of the tertiary sector employed to the total number of employed in all economic activities. Hereafter, called "Rate of 3rd sector employed". This "Rate of 3rd sector employed" shows further developed area than "Rate of 2nd & 3rd sector employed" if the Petty-Clark's Law can be applied.

Looking at Map V, the area where "Rate of 3rd sector employed" is more than 67.2% is narrower than the area where "Rate of 2nd & 3rd sector employed" is more than 95.2% on Map III. 67.2% is the nation-wise average rate of Japan. It might be possible to say that the area where "Rate of 3rd sector employed" is more than 67.2% is the most developed area in Phnom Penh area if the Petty-Clark's Law can be applied.
