Problems Encountered in Last Censuses

- Undercount in the Bangkok Metropolis and other big cities
 - Flat, Condo, Apt.
 - Housing Projects, Slum
- Undercount of international migrants
- High turn over rate of enumerators and field staff
- ICR System (first use in 2000)



I. Progress in Strategic Plan of 2010 PHC

- Establishing the cooperation among alliance agencies i.e. Min. of Interior, Labor, Education, Pubic Health, Social dev. and Human security, Agriculture and cooperatives, NESDB and Thai Post
- Organizing seminar for high-rise building association

New Initiatives in 2010 PHC (Cont.)

- . Setting-up Telephone Interview Center
 - Training interviewers
 - Trial on regular surveys in BMA.
 - . Develop Digital Map: Incorporate basic information of EAs.
 - Locate high-rise builds, housing project
 - Identify major characteristics. (no of floors, no of houses etc.)
 - Contact addresses/persons




New Initiatives in 2010 PHC (Cont.)

- . Develop Multimode for Data Collection:SOA Providing Respondents wt. Multi-choices
 - Face to face interview
 - Self-enumeration
 - Dropped-off / picked-up (mail) questionnaire
 - Telephone interview via TIC
 - Internet

Work Done

- 1. Pilot project in Pitsanulok province
 - 81 EA
 - enumerators local government officers, village health voluntary
 - data collection; interview, leave out questionnaire and mail
- 2. Pilot project on Incorporating Migrant Population in Tak, Chonburi and Bangkok



Lesson learned from Incorporating Migrant Population in 2010 PHC

- Difficulties to access International migrants
- Lack of cooperation / need good understanding about census
- Difficulties in communication with migrants
 - not allow to talk to others
 - language barrier
- Self- enumeration questionnaire designed for high-rise building



New Initiatives in 2010 PHC (Cont.)

- . Developing a Survey Technique and Outreach Strategy for Incorporating Migrant Populations in PHC 2010
 - Pretest in 2007, 2008 : Tak, Chonburi, Bangkok
 - Share lesson learnt




Improvement of ICT System

- . Improve Data Capturing/Processing
 - Install scanner at provinces or cluster of provinces
 - Increase ICR system capacity
 - Improve data processing system
 - Hardware
 - Software

- . Pilot project in Pitsanulok Prov. (2008)
- . Pilot project in 2 districts in BMA (2009)
- . Develop training VCD
- . Continuous dialogue wt. users to draft census questionnaire
- . Continuous dialogue wt. users to review standard classification: ed., ind., occ.
