

## Notes on the Statistical Tables

1. 2019 Economic Census for Business Frame was conducted for establishments excluding the following establishments:
  - (1) Individual proprietorships belonging to Japan Standard Industrial Classification Category A - "Agriculture and Forestry"
  - (2) Individual proprietorships belonging to Japan Standard Industrial Classification Category B - "Fisheries"
  - (3) Establishments belonging to the group 792 - "Household services" in Japan Standard Industrial Classification Category N -"Living-Related and Personal Services and Amusement Services"
  - (4) Establishments belonging to the major group 96 - "Foreign public affairs" in Japan Standard Industrial Classification Category R - "Services, n.e.c."
  
2. 2019 Economic Census for Business Frame consists of two types of questionnaires, Questionnaire A and Questionnaire B. Questionnaire A covers privately owned establishments and Questionnaire B covers establishments of national and local governments.

The results of Questionnaire A were obtained from the survey conducted from June 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020 and the results of Questionnaire B were the figures as of June 1, 2019.
  
3. "Newly grasped establishments" has a definition different from that of conventionally used "Newly established establishments". In this survey, the corporate number is used to add the establishments, which have been registered to the National Tax Agency Corporate Number Publication Site but have not been identified by the former surveys, to the survey name list. Therefore, the name of "Newly grasped establishments" is used to show that it identifies establishments from the viewpoint wider than that of conventional "Newly established establishments".
  
4. "Newly grasped enterprises, etc." refer to enterprises, etc. that were newly grasped in the 2019 Economic Census for Business Frame and continue to conduct economic activities. However, an enterprise, etc. of which head offices (headquarters, main offices) has been transferred from another location and newly created in the present location is also included.
  
5. Some items, such as the amount of sales (income), were tallied based on establishments (enterprises, etc.) for which values of the necessary items were obtained.

6. The amount of sales (income) represents the figure for the full year of 2018. The amount of sales (income) is recognized in principle as the values including the consumption tax, however as for some answers that contain the values without the consumption tax, their values are tallied and listed in the result table after converted into the values containing the consumption tax according to the "Guidelines on the Treatment of the Consumption Tax in Relation to the Tabulation of the Amount of Sales, etc. in Statistical Surveys" (agreed upon by the directors of the divisions with the main jurisdiction over statistical affairs at ministries and agencies on May 19, 2015)."

7. For the amount of sales (income), figures below the expression unit are rounded off. Therefore, the sum of breakdown is not consistent with the total in some cases. In addition, the percentage (proportion) is rounded off to two decimal places.
8. Some of the data are shown as "-" because they lack relevant numbers. Negative values are shown as "▲".
9. "X" represents sections in which the relevant figure is concealed in cases where secret of individual reporters would be leaked if the tabulation result were directly published since the number of establishments (enterprises, etc.) to be tabulated is 1 or 2. Additionally, "X" is used also for sections in which the figure of one or two establishments (enterprises, etc.) to be tabulated is found based on the difference with the sum, even if the number of establishments (enterprises, etc.) to be tabulated is 3 or more.
