

Summary of the Results (Privately Owned)

I Overview of Enterprises

As of June 1, 2024, there were 2,549,827 enterprises in Japan.

In addition, the amount of sales(income) (hereinafter referred to as “Sales”) in 2023 were 1976.0205 trillion yen.

(1) Number of Enterprises

Looking at the number of enterprises, by industry division, the number was the largest for “Wholesale and retail trade” at 492,141 (19.3% of all industries), followed by “Construction” at 345,636 (13.6%), and “Manufacturing” at 242,949 (9.5%), resulting in the top three industries accounting for 42.4% of all industries.

(2) Sales

Looking at sales, sales were the largest for “Wholesale and retail trade” at 530.7635 trillion yen (26.9% of all industries), followed by “Manufacturing” at 464.3951 trillion yen (23.5%), and “Medical, health care and welfare” at 191.7585 trillion yen (9.7%), resulting in the top three industries accounting for 60.1% of all industries.

(3) Sales per enterprise

Looking at sales per enterprise, sales were the largest for “Electricity, gas, heat supply and water” at 7.07618 billion yen, followed by “Finance and insurance” at 6.32200 billion yen, and “Mining and quarrying of stone and gravel” at 1.96073 billion yen.

*3 The categories of each industry are as follows:

Primary industry "Agriculture, forestry and fisheries"

Secondary industry "Mining and quarrying of stone and gravel", "Construction" and "Manufacturing"

Tertiary industry "Electricity, gas, heat supply and water", "Information and communications", "Transport and postal services", "Wholesale and retail trade", "Finance and insurance", "Real estate and goods rental and leasing", "Scientific research, professional and technical services", "Accommodations, eating and drinking services", "Living-related and personal services and amusement services", "Education, learning support", "Medical, health care and welfare", "Compound services" and "Services, n.e.c."

II Overview of Establishments

As of June 1, 2024, there were 5,060,494 privately owned establishments (hereinafter referred to as "the number of all establishments"). Of these, there were 4,023,941 establishments excluding establishments not reporting their industry, etc. (hereinafter referred to as "the number of establishments"), and 56,285,043 persons engaged.

(1) Number of establishments

Looking at the number of establishments by industry division, the number was largest for "Wholesale and retail trade" at 964,106 (24.0% of all industries), followed by "Medical, health care and welfare" at 433,229 (10.8%), and "Construction" at 400,342 (9.9%), resulting in the top three industries accounting for 44.7% of all industries.

(2) Number of persons engaged

Looking at the number of persons engaged by industry division, the number was the largest for "Wholesale and retail trade" at 10,797,668 (19.2% of all industries), followed by "Manufacturing" at 8,411,995 (14.9%), and "Medical, health care and welfare" at 8,375,640 (14.9%), resulting in the top three industries accounting for 49.0% of all industries.

(3) Number of persons engaged per establishment

Looking at the number of persons engaged per establishment, the number was the largest for "Manufacturing" at 26.6, followed by "Transport and postal services" at 26.1 and "Information and communications" at 25.2. On the other hand, the number was the smallest for "Real estate and goods rental and leasing" at 5.1, followed by "Living-related and personal services and amusement services" at 8.4, and "Construction" at 8.6.
