

Summary of the Result of 2019 Economic Conditions Survey - First Tabulation

The sales (income) (hereinafter referred to as “sales”) by industry division in 2018 was the largest for “wholesale and retail trade” at 498.0 trillion yen, followed by “manufacturing” at 413.2 trillion yen, and “finance and insurance” at 118.3 trillion yen.

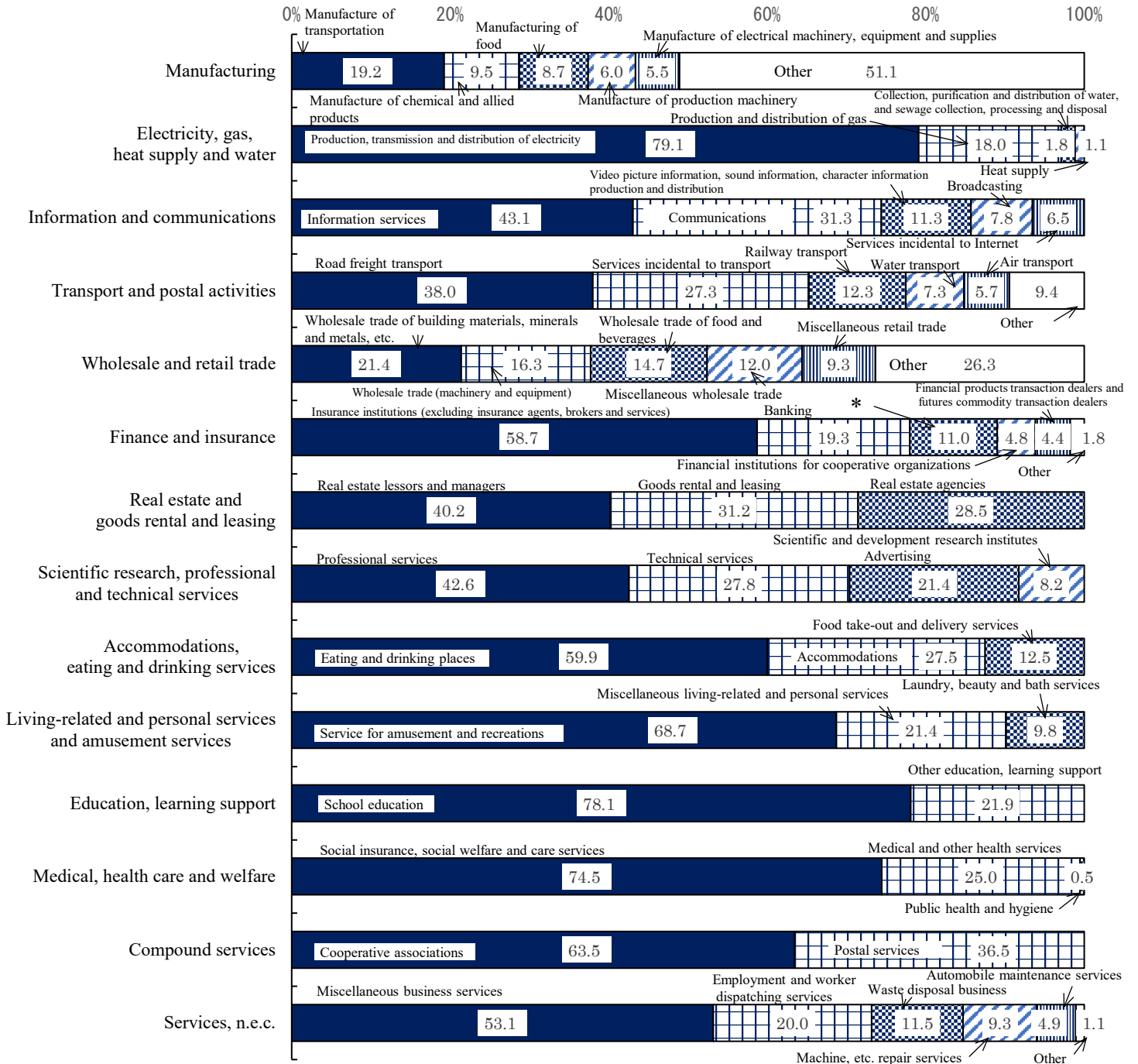

Note: Concerning some enterprises that belong to Manufacturing, Their data are transferred from the Census of Manufacture that was conducted together with Economic Conditions Survey at the same time. The first tabulation of the Economic Conditions Survey use the preliminary results of the Census of Manufacture.

Looking at the sales composition ratio of Major Groups by Industry, “manufacture of transportation equipment” (19.2%) is the highest under “Manufacturing,” “production, transmission and distribution of electricity” (79.1%) under “Electricity, gas, heat supply and water,” “information services” (43.1%) under “Information and communications,” “road freight transport” (38.0%) under “Transport and postal activities,” and “wholesale trade (building materials, minerals and metals, etc.” (21.4%) under “wholesale and retail trade” respectively.
