

2020 Economic Conditions Survey

The First Tabulation

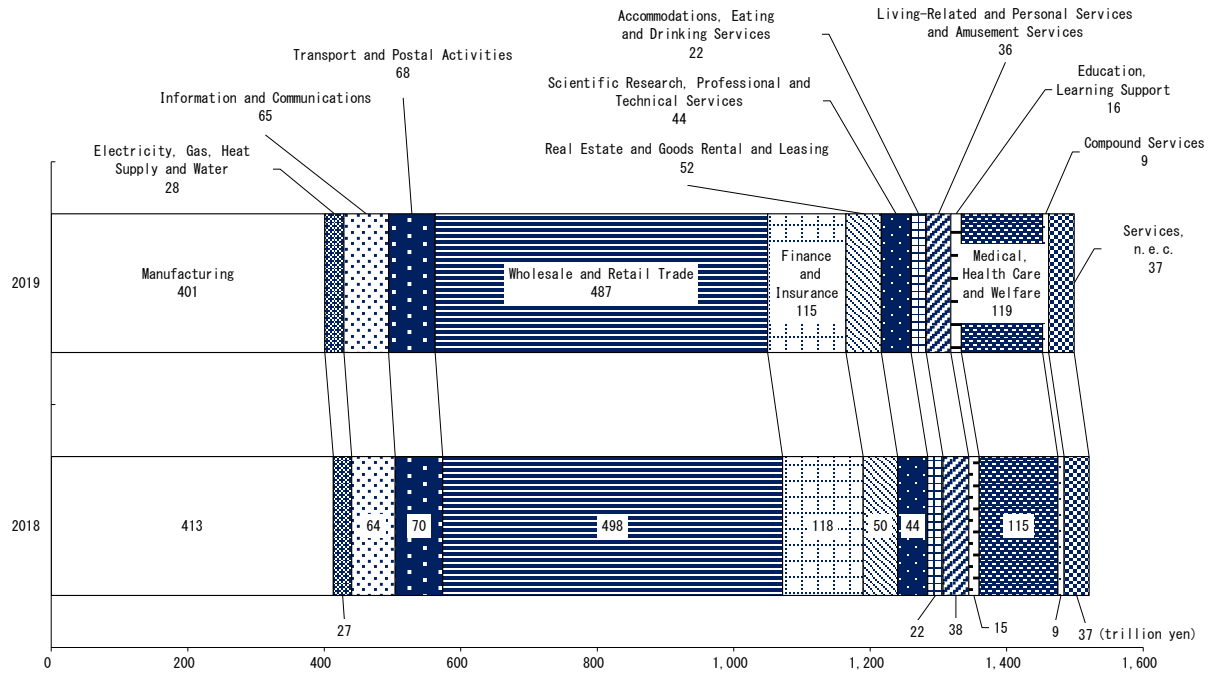
The amount of sales (income) (hereinafter referred to as “sales”) by industry division in 2019 was the largest for “Wholesale and retail trade” at 487.1 trillion yen, followed by “Manufacturing” at 400.9 trillion yen, and “Medical, health care and welfare” at 118.9 trillion yen.

A comparison with 2018 regarding the top three industries shows that the sales decreased by 2.2% in “Wholesale and retail trade,” decreased by 3.0% in “Manufacturing” and increased by 2.9% in “Medical, health care and welfare.”

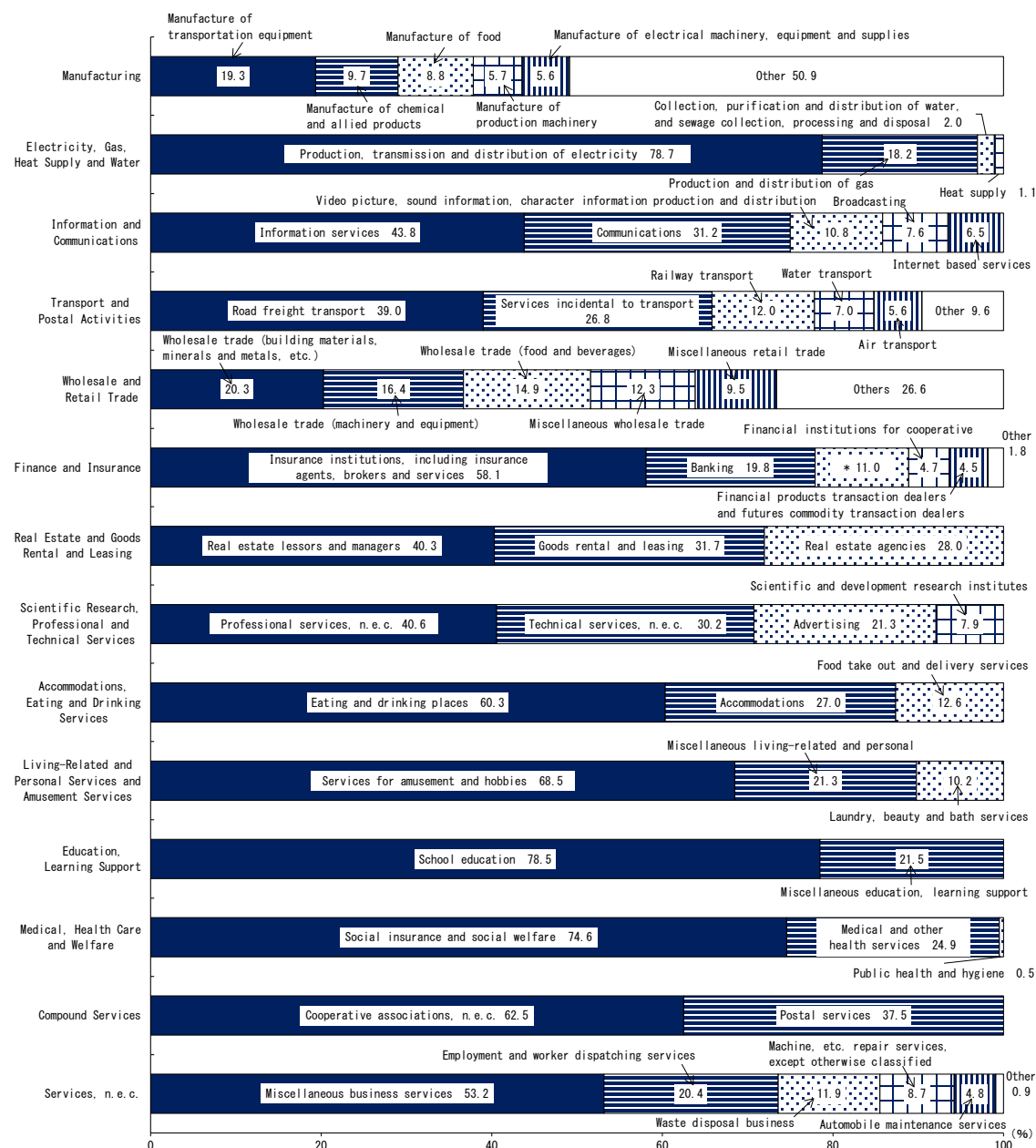

Looking at the sales composition ratio of major groups by industry, “Manufacture of transportation equipment” (19.3%) is the highest under “Manufacturing,” “Production, transmission and distribution of electricity” (78.7%) under “Electricity, gas, heat supply and water,” “Information services” (43.8%) under “Information and communications,” “Road freight transport” (39.0%) under “Transport and postal activities” respectively.
