

**2022 Annual Business Survey**  
**The First Tabulation**  
- Tabulation of enterprises, etc. for ABS (All Industry Enterprise)

● The amount of sales (income) (hereinafter referred to as “sales”) by industry division in 2021 was the largest for “Wholesale and Retail Trade” at 478.0 trillion yen, followed by “Manufacturing” at 415.7 trillion yen, and “Medical, Health Care and Welfare” at 143.0 trillion yen.

A comparison with 2020 regarding the top three industries shows that the sales increased by 1.1% in “Wholesale and Retail Trade,” increased by 6.7% in “Manufacturing” and decreased by 14.8% in “Medical, Health Care and Welfare.”

● The number of enterprises, etc. by industry division in 2022 was the largest for “Wholesale and Retail Trade” at 422,362 followed by “Construction” at 320,720, and “Manufacturing” at 243,043.

A comparison with 2021 regarding the top three industries shows that the number of enterprises, etc. increased by 1.0% in “Wholesale and Retail Trade,” increased by 1.8% in “Construction” and increased by 0.7% in “Manufacturing.”

Figure 1: Composition ratios of number of enterprises, etc. and sales by industry division

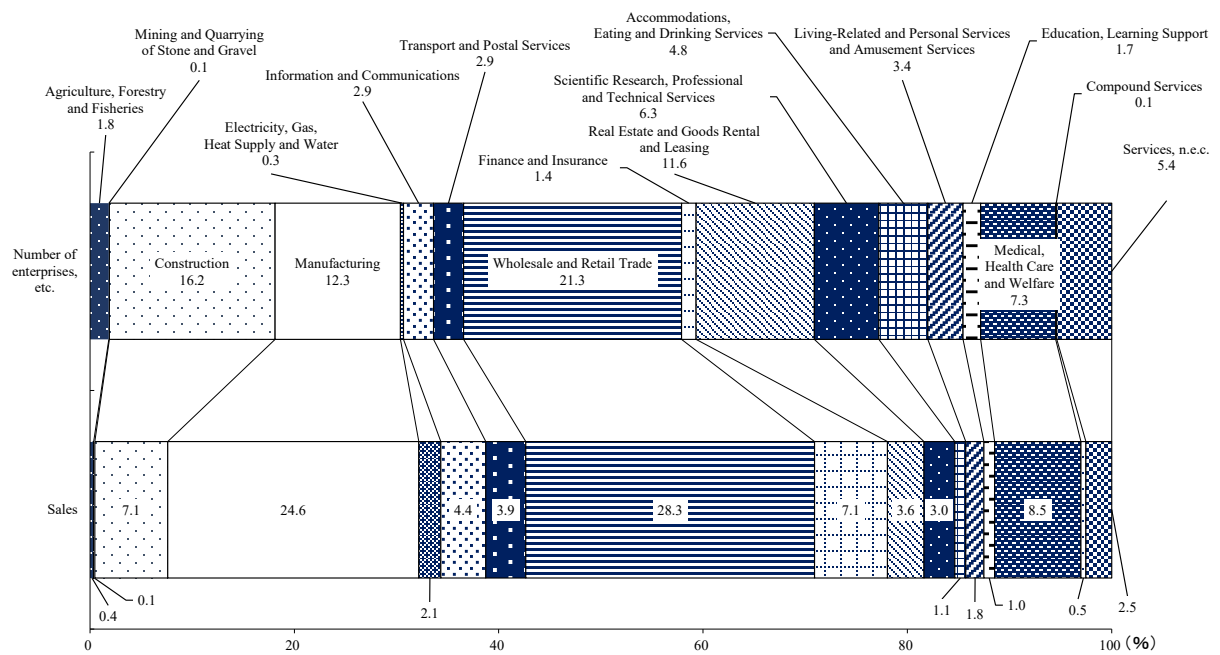
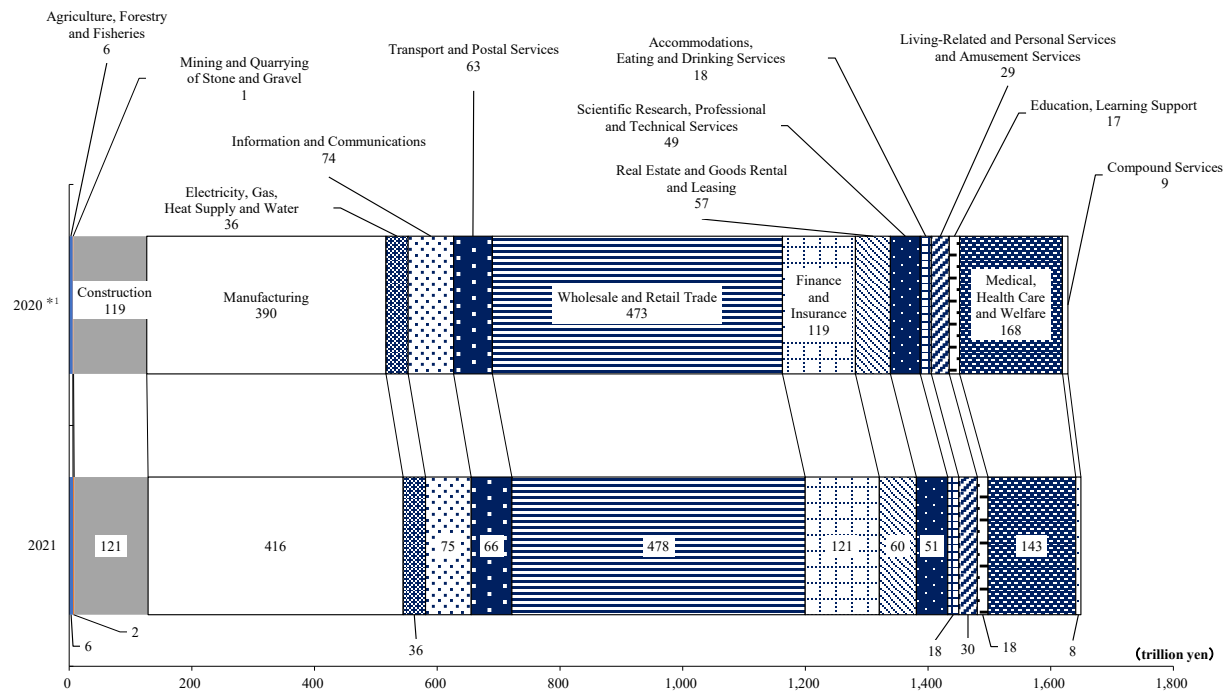


Figure 2: Change in sales by industry division\*2

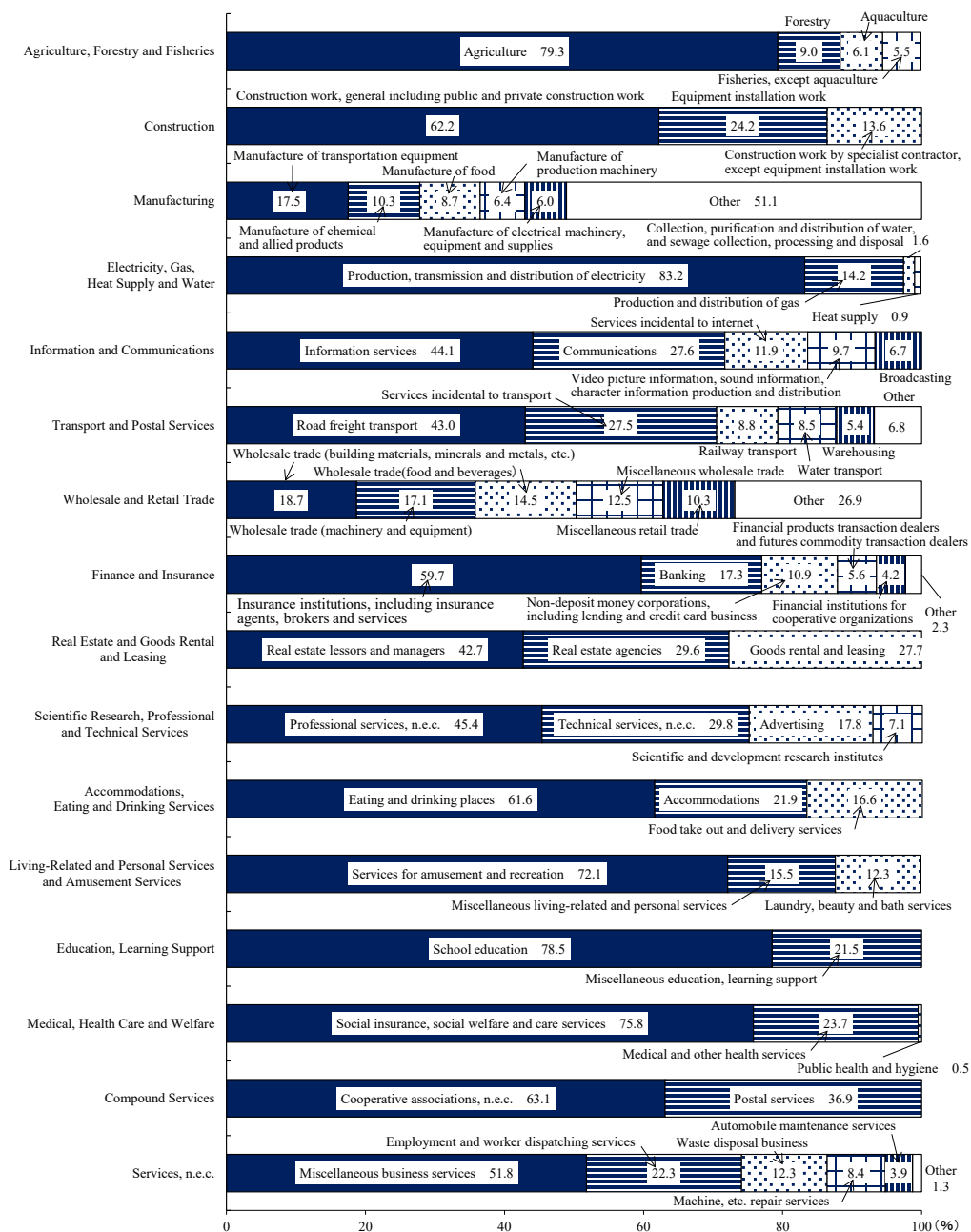

Looking at the sales composition ratio of major groups by industry, “Production, transmission and distribution of electricity” (83.2%) is the highest under “Electricity, Gas, Heat Supply and Water,” “Agriculture” (79.3%) under “Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries,” “School education” (78.5%) under “Education, Learning Support,” “Social insurance, social welfare and care services,” (75.8%) under “Medical, Health Care and Welfare,” “Services for amusement and recreation,” (72.1%) under “Living-Related and Personal Services and Amusement Services.”
