


1. Sales by industry division (Tabulation of enterprises, etc.)

Sales of enterprises, etc. (Total industries) was 1,714.2624 trillion yen. Looking at sales by industry division, sales was the largest for "Wholesale and Retail Trade" at 486.1151 trillion yen, (28.4% of the total industries) followed by "Manufacturing" at 415.9608 trillion yen (24.3%), and "Medical, Health Care and Welfare" at 148.2374 trillion yen (8.6%) (Table 1, Figure).

2. Sales by prefecture and industry division (Tabulation of establishments)

Looking at sales by prefecture and industry division concerning establishments, sales in "Wholesale and Retail Trade" was the largest in Tokyo at 199.8126 trillion yen (33.4% of the total for all prefectures), followed by Osaka at 62.9303 trillion yen (10.5%), and Aichi at 44.0365 trillion yen (7.4%).

Concerning "Manufacturing," sales was the largest in Aichi at 49.2509 trillion yen (14.2%), followed by Osaka at 19.8302 trillion yen (5.7%), and Kanagawa at 19.4132 trillion yen (5.6%).

Concerning "Medical, Health Care and Welfare," sales was the largest in Tokyo at 40.5946 trillion yen (27.1%), followed by Osaka at 9.6069 trillion yen (6.4%), and Kanagawa at 7.7530 trillion yen (5.2%) (Table 2).
