

## 2023 Annual Business Survey

### The Third Tabulation

#### - Tabulation of establishments for ABS (All Industry Enterprise)

##### 1. Sales by prefecture and industry division

Looking at sales by prefecture and industry division concerning establishments, sales in “Wholesale and Retail Trade” was the largest in Tokyo at 225.2227 trillion yen (35.1% of the total for all prefectures), followed by Osaka at 67.6761 trillion yen (10.6%), and Aichi at 47.0708 trillion yen (7.3%).

Concerning “Manufacturing,” sales was the largest in Aichi at 53.5187 trillion yen (14.3%), followed by Osaka at 21.7860 trillion yen (5.8%), and Shizuoka at 19.6248 trillion yen (5.3%).

Concerning “Medical, Health Care and Welfare,” sales was the largest in Tokyo at 32.9311 trillion yen (23.6%), followed by Osaka at 9.4152 trillion yen (6.7%), and Kanagawa at 7.7733 trillion yen (5.6%) (Table 1).

## 2. Annual sales of goods by prefecture (Wholesale and Retail Trade)

Looking at the annual sales of goods by prefecture concerning “Wholesale and Retail Trade,” in “Wholesale Trade,” the amount was the largest in Tokyo at 190.1185 trillion yen (41.6% of the total for all prefectures), followed by Osaka at 54.1988 trillion yen (11.9%), and Aichi at 36.3207 trillion yen (7.9%).

Concerning “Retail Trade,” the amount was the largest in Tokyo at 21.8152 trillion yen (15.0%), followed by Osaka at 10.1208 trillion yen (7.0%), and Kanagawa at 8.9578 trillion yen (6.2%) (Table 2).

### 3. Annual sales of goods by industry group (Wholesale and Retail Trade)

Looking at the annual sales of goods by industry group concerning “Wholesale and Retail Trade,” in “Wholesale Trade,” the amount was the largest in “Electrical machinery, equipment and supplies” at 53.7255 trillion yen (11.8% of Wholesale Trade), followed by “Food and beverages” at 53.0625 trillion yen (11.6%) and “Medicines and toiletries” at 36.4606 trillion yen (8.0%).

Concerning “Retail Trade,” the amount was the largest in “Motor vehicles” at 20.5100 trillion yen (14.1% of Retail Trade), followed by “Grocery stores” at 20.3758 trillion yen (14.0%), and “Medicine and toiletry stores” at 14.4016 trillion yen (9.9%) (Table 3-1, Table 3-2).
