- Tabulation of establishments for ABS (All Industry Enterprise)

1. Sales by prefecture and industry division

Looking at sales by prefecture and industry division concerning establishments, sales in “Wholesale and Retail Trade” was the largest in Tokyo at 229.8888 trillion yen (34.6% of the total for all prefectures), followed by Osaka at 70.1428 trillion yen (10.6%), and Aichi at 49.8909 trillion yen (7.5%).

Concerning “Manufacturing,” sales was the largest in Aichi at 59.2695 trillion yen (15.4%), followed by Osaka at 20.4682 trillion yen (5.3%), and Shizuoka at 20.1044 trillion yen (5.2%).

Concerning “Medical, Health Care and Welfare,” sales was the largest in Tokyo at 78.9815 trillion yen (42.1%), followed by Osaka at 9.6872 trillion yen (5.2%), and Kanagawa at 7.9476 trillion yen (4.2%) (Table 1).

2. Annual sales of goods by prefecture (Wholesale and Retail Trade)

Looking at the annual sales of goods by prefecture concerning “Wholesale and Retail Trade,” in “Wholesale Trade,” the amount was the largest in Tokyo at 194.6975 trillion yen (41.0% of the total for all prefectures), followed by Osaka at 55.9491 trillion yen (11.8%), and Aichi at 38.7207 trillion yen (8.2%).

Concerning “Retail Trade,” the amount was the largest in Tokyo at 22.3989 trillion yen (14.9%), followed by Osaka at 10.9114 trillion yen (7.3%), and Kanagawa at 9.2424 trillion yen (6.1%) (Table 2).

3. Annual sales of goods by industry group (Wholesale and Retail Trade)

Looking at the annual sales of goods by industry group concerning “Wholesale and Retail Trade,” in “Wholesale Trade,” the amount was the largest in “Food and beverages” at 57.2368 trillion yen (12.1% of Wholesale Trade), followed by “Electrical machinery, equipment and supplies” at 56.3546 trillion yen (11.9%) and “Medicines and toiletries” at 39.8116 trillion yen (8.4%).

Concerning “Retail Trade,” the amount was the largest in “Motor vehicles” at 22.9062 trillion yen (15.2% of Retail Trade), followed by “Grocery stores” at 21.4367 trillion yen (14.3%), and “Fuel stores” at 13.3744 trillion yen (8.9%) (Table 3-1, Table 3-2).
