Fourth tabulation includes individual proprietorship enterprises and establishments under the enterprises in addition to corporations and establishments which covered by First through Third tabulation.

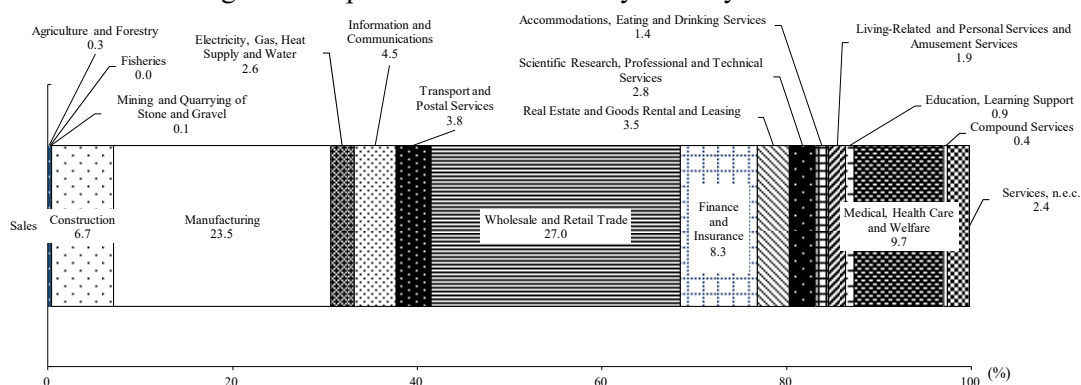
1. Sales by industry division (Tabulation of enterprises, etc.)

Sales of enterprises, etc. (Total industries) was 1,975.1591 trillion yen. Looking at sales by industry division, sales was the largest for “Wholesale and Retail Trade” at 532.3387 trillion yen, (27.0% of the total industries) followed by “Manufacturing” at 464.6769 trillion yen (23.5%), and “Medical, Health Care and Welfare” at 192.0214 trillion yen (9.7%) (Table 1, Figure).

2. Sales by prefecture and industry division (Tabulation of establishments)

Looking at sales by prefecture and industry division concerning establishments, sales in “Wholesale and Retail Trade” was the largest in Tokyo at 235.0657 trillion yen (34.7% of the total for all prefectures), followed by Osaka at 71.1288 trillion yen (10.5%), and Aichi at 50.8233 trillion yen (7.5%).

Concerning “Manufacturing,” sales was the largest in Aichi at 60.6875 trillion yen (15.1%), followed by Osaka at 22.1443 trillion yen (5.5%), and Kanagawa at 20.7152 trillion yen (5.2%).

Concerning “Medical, Health Care and Welfare,” sales was the largest in Tokyo at 80.4637 trillion yen (41.4%), followed by Osaka at 10.2253 trillion yen (5.3%), and Kanagawa at 8.4085 trillion yen (4.3%) (Table 2).
