

Division O – EDUCATION, LEARNING SUPPORT

Overview of the Division

This Division comprises establishments engaged in school education, those engaged in systematic education activities other than school education, those engaged in providing supplementary lessons to school education, and those engaged in providing instruction services for arts, culture, skills and techniques.

Establishments engaged in correspondence education, supplementary tutorial schools, libraries, museums, botanical gardens, etc. are also included in this classification.

Establishments engaged in providing facilities for sports are classified in the Division N – LIVING-RELATED AND PERSONAL SERVICES AND AMUSEMENT SERVICES [80].

Major group 81 – SCHOOL EDUCATION

Overview of the Major group

This Major group comprises establishments engaged in teaching specified courses of education and establishments engaged in providing support for school education.

This refers to the establishments, as the headquarters primarily engaged in controlling establishments of school education, engaged in the operations except the work-site operations for managing and controlling operations across the whole organization to promote the management of its own corporation, Personnel affairs/personnel training, general affairs, financial affairs/accounting, legal affairs, intellectual property management, planning, public information/advertising, business support, investigation/research and development, production/project management, real estate management, information system management, management of equipments and materials, contract, service/material procurement.

This refers to establishments primarily engaged in education for nursing infants and developing their mind and body.

This refers to the establishments primarily engaged in general education

performed for compulsory education, based on that in the elementary schools.

8132 Compulsory education schools

This refers to establishments that consistently provide general education in the form of compulsory education from the basics.

814 UPPER SECONDARY SCHOOLS, SECONDARY SCHOOLS

8141 Upper secondary schools

This refers to establishments primarily engaged in high level general education and professional training, based on education in the lower secondary schools.

The establishments engaged in correspondence course based on the school education act are included in this classification.

8142 Secondary schools

This refers to establishments engaged in general education performed for compulsory education, and high level general education and professional training consistently, based on education in the elementary schools.

The establishments engaged in correspondence course based on the school education act are included in this classification.

815 SCHOOLS FOR SPECIAL NEEDS EDUCATION

8151 Schools for special needs education

This refers to the establishments engaged in the education for visually impaired, hearing handicapped, mentally-disabled person, person of limbs inconvenience or weakling (including the physical weakling), according to kindergartens, elementary schools, lower secondary schools or upper secondary schools, and at the same time, providing education for necessary knowledge and skill to make up for their handicap.

816 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

8161 Universities

This class comprises establishments that broadly impart learning primarily in academic disciplines, as well as undertaking intensive education and research in specialized fields and developing intellectual, moral, and practical abilities.

Establishments that offer professional and vocational university programs and

correspondence courses in accordance with the School Education Law are also included in this class.

Junior colleges are classified under Industry 8162.

8162 Junior colleges

This class comprises establishments that undertake intensive education and research in specialized fields, and offer education designed to foster the abilities needed for specific professions or daily life.

Establishments that offer professional and vocational college programs and correspondence courses in accordance with the School Education Law are also included in this class.

8163 Colleges of technology

This class comprises establishments that undertake intensive education in specialized fields, and offer education designed to foster the abilities needed for specific professions.

817 SPECIALIZED TRAINING COLLEGES AND OTHER SCHOOLS

8171 Specialized training colleges

This class comprises establishments that offer education designed to foster the abilities needed for specific professions or daily life or to improve liberal education.

8172 Other schools

This class comprises establishments that offer education equivalent to school education in accordance with the School Education Law.

818 SCHOOL EDUCATION SUPPORT INSTITUTIONS

8181 Support institutions for higher education institutions

This refers to establishments engaged in support activities for higher education institutions, such as evaluation of the higher education institution and the implementation of the common university entrance exam, etc.

However, if an evaluation agency is not primarily engaged in the evaluation of higher education institutions, it is classified into the respective industry according to its primary business.

**819 INTEGRATED CENTERS FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND
CARE**

8191 Integrated centers for early childhood education and care

 This refers to establishments primarily engaged in school education services for children, nursery services as child welfare facilities, and child care support services for parents integrally.

Major group 82 – OTHER EDUCATION, LEARNING SUPPORT

Overview of the Major group

This Major group comprises establishments engaged in systematic education activities other than school education, those engaged in providing supplementary lessons to school education, and those engaged in providing instruction services for the arts, culture and technical skills.

This refers to the establishments, as the head offices primarily engaged in controlling establishments of miscellaneous education, learning support, engaged in the operations except the work-site operations, such as personnel affairs/personnel training, general affairs, financial affairs/accounting, legal affairs, intellectual property management, planning, public information/advertising, investigation/research and development, production/project management, real estate management, information system management, management of equipments and materials, buying/raw materials purchase, service/material procurement, to promote the management of its own enterprise.

This refers to the establishments engaged in support operations of transportation, cleaning, repair/maintenance, preservation, to other establishments belonging to the same enterprise, to primarily promote activities in the miscellaneous education, learning support.

This class comprises establishments engaged in various activities related to education, academic disciplines, and culture that have direct relevance to real life for the residents of municipalities or other specific areas.

8212 Libraries

This class comprises establishments engaged in gathering, organizing, and storing books, records and other necessary materials, and making them available for use by the general public or specific individuals.

8213 Museums and art museums

This class comprises establishments engaged in gathering, archiving, and exhibiting materials related to history, art, folklore, industry, natural science, etc., and making them available for use by the general public.

8214 Zoological gardens, botanical gardens and aquariums

This class comprises establishments engaged in displaying flora and fauna to the general public.

8215 Centers for children and youths

This class comprises establishments engaged in educational activities designed to foster the mental and physical wellbeing of children and youths.

8216 Correspondence social education

This class comprises establishments engaged in sending educational materials, teaching support materials, and others to students based on a fixed teaching plan by means of correspondence, as well as setting and answering questions, giving corrective guidance, answering questions, and others based on this. Establishments that provide accredited correspondence social education based on the Social Education Law and establishments that provide non-accredited correspondence social education conducted by profit-seeking organizations, individuals, etc. are also included in this class.

However, correspondence education in accordance with the School Education Law is not included in this class.

8219 Other social education

This class comprises establishments engaged in social education that is not classified elsewhere.

822

VOCATIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT FACILITIES

- 8221 Employee training facilities and supporting facilities
This refers to the establishments engaged in education/training for personnel belonging to government offices or enterprise office for business performance by the office, or the establishments engaged in education/training for personnel belonging to government offices or enterprise office for business performance with entrustment from government offices or the enterprise offices.
- 8222 Vocational guidance centers
This class comprises establishments officially engaged in vocational ability development, skill training, etc.
- 8229 Other vocational and educational support facilities
This class comprises establishments engaged in operating vocational or educational support facilities that are not classified elsewhere.
- 823 SUPPLEMENTARY TUTORIAL SCHOOLS**
- 8231 Supplementary tutorial schools
This class comprises establishments engaged in supplementary teaching of school education or learning guidance for elementary school children, lower secondary school pupils, upper secondary school pupils, etc.
- 824 INSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR ARTS, CULTURE AND TECHNICALS**
- 8241 Music instructions
This class comprises establishments primarily engaged in teaching skills and techniques related to music.
- 8242 Calligraphy instructions
This class comprises establishments primarily engaged in teaching calligraphy.
- 8243 Flower, tea ceremony instructions
This class comprises establishments primarily engaged in teaching *ikebana* (flower arrangement) and tea ceremony.
- 8244 Abacus instructions
This class comprises establishments primarily engaged in teaching abacus.

- 8245 Foreign language instructions
This class comprises establishments primarily engaged in teaching foreign language conversation.
- 8246 Sports and health instructions
This refers to establishments engaged in lesson for swimming, yoga, exercises etc. by the leaders for improvement of sports skill, health, and beauty as their principal objectives.
However, even in the case where lessons are actually provided, the establishments primarily engaged in providing facilities to play sports are classified in Division N-LIVING-RELATED AND PERSONAL SERVICES AND AMUSEMENT SERVICES [804].
- 8249 Other instruction services for arts, culture and technicals
This class comprises establishments engaged in teaching liberal education, skills, hobby activities, and others that are not classified elsewhere.
- 829 EDUCATION, LEARNING SUPPORT, N.E.C.**
- 8299 Education, learning support, n.e.c.
This class comprises establishments engaged in education and learning support services that are not classified elsewhere.
Establishments that provide systematic and organized education for the purpose of acquiring qualifications and skills without being based on the School Education Law are also included in this class.
