Where figures are to be entered, write one digit per square .

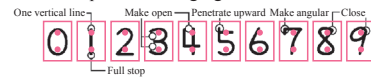
Please write using a **black pencil** or **black mechanical pencil** and erase mistakes cleanly by using an eraser.

I Yearly Income

About how much was the income of your household in the past one year (from November 2018 to October 2019)?

- Please enter the income amount of each household member by type of income.
- The household head is not simply a person called this nominally, but the person who is living with and **earning the majority of the income of the household**.
- If the person **"who earns the majority of the income of the household"** has been absent for more than three months, choose as household head a representative from among the household members.
- Regarding other household members, enter the total income of the corresponding members of ③ and ④.
- If you are not sure who earned a particular income, please include that income as part of the household head's income.
- Exclude temporary income, such as retirement allowance, income from selling of land, house, stock, etc. and inherited savings.

Because the questionnaire will be read mechanically, please keep it clean, flat, and free from folding.
