





Percentage of countries/organizations by number of employees in register units




(Number of employees)

Percentage of countries/organization by period of establishment of the register




> 45% established SBR in the 1990s

     enterprise groups or other statistical units (KAU etc.)
  - b. Profiling: Planning, coordination of the working group, pilot work

- a. Automatic loading (deleting) procedure
- Remote access to the BR data for administrative institutions, exchange of data with websites.
