 - Enterprises
 - Local Units
 - Legal units and local legal units
- Sources
 - Chamber of Commerce (CoC)
 - Tax Authority (TA)
 - Profilers



Starting situation (2)

- Users
 - All Dutch SN statistics on economic developments
- Roles of Dutch SBR (most important)
 - SBR Live Register
 - SBR Register Snapshot and Frozen Frame
 - SBR Survey Frame
 - SBR Information Source
- Other info
 - Monthly frozen frames
 - Available to all users
 - Macro quality validation



Starting situation (3)

- Dutch Central Bank responsible for most of data collection on financial units. Integrated in NA
- Different units used by both organisations
- Risk of integration problems in NA
- SBR has undercoverage. Due to restrictions of CoC register
- Improvement needed in SBR for
 - Government units
 - Financial units
 - Globalisation/regionalisation
 - Beneficial for employment statistics

- Introduction of globalisation aspect
- Improved regional information

- Bottom up derivation of institutional sector classification

- Better statistical coordination
- Better description of the financial and public sector in SBR and therefor in NA
