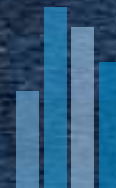

- ...

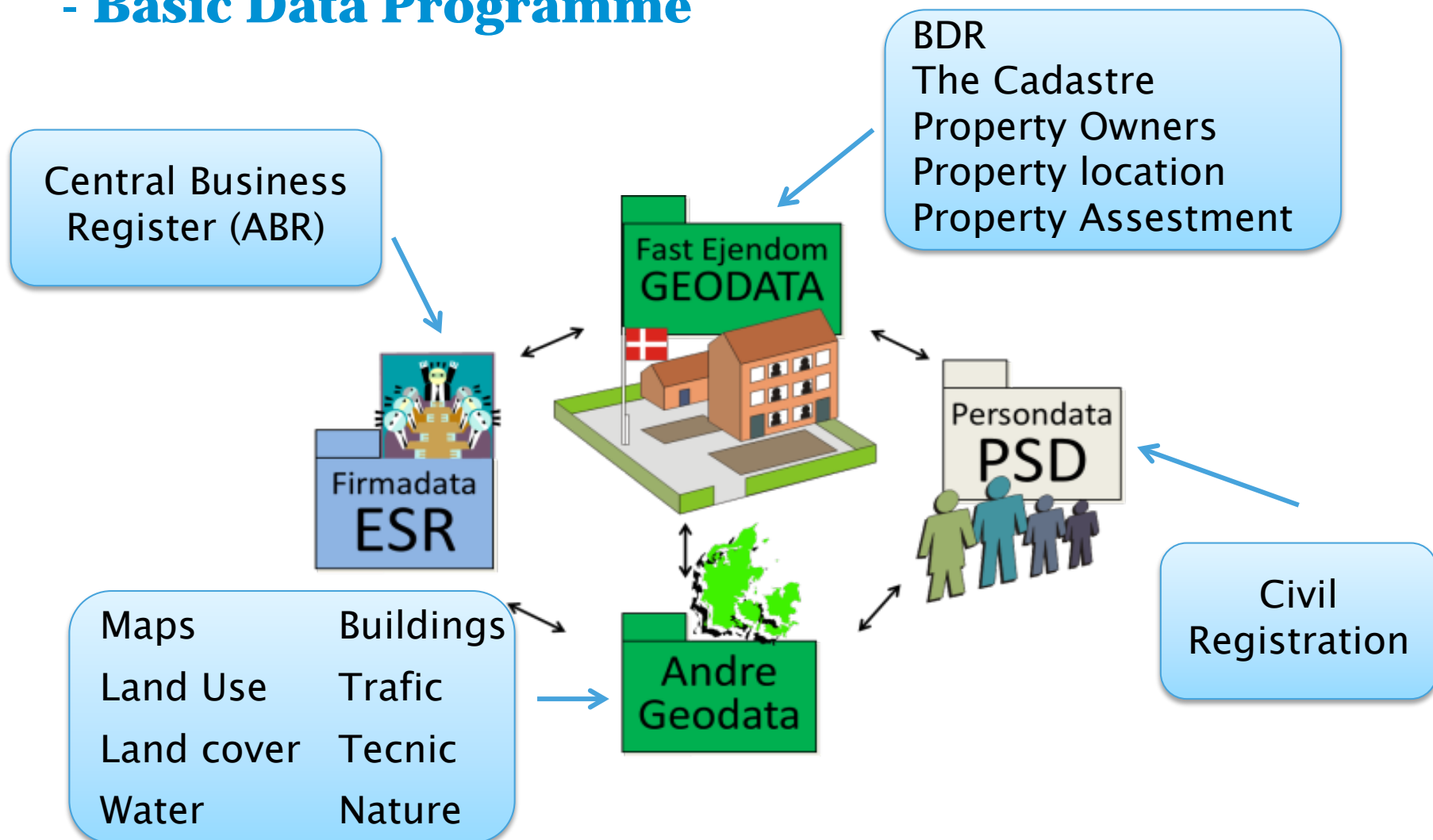
Sharing information is natural

- Sharing information, but also duplication of almost same data

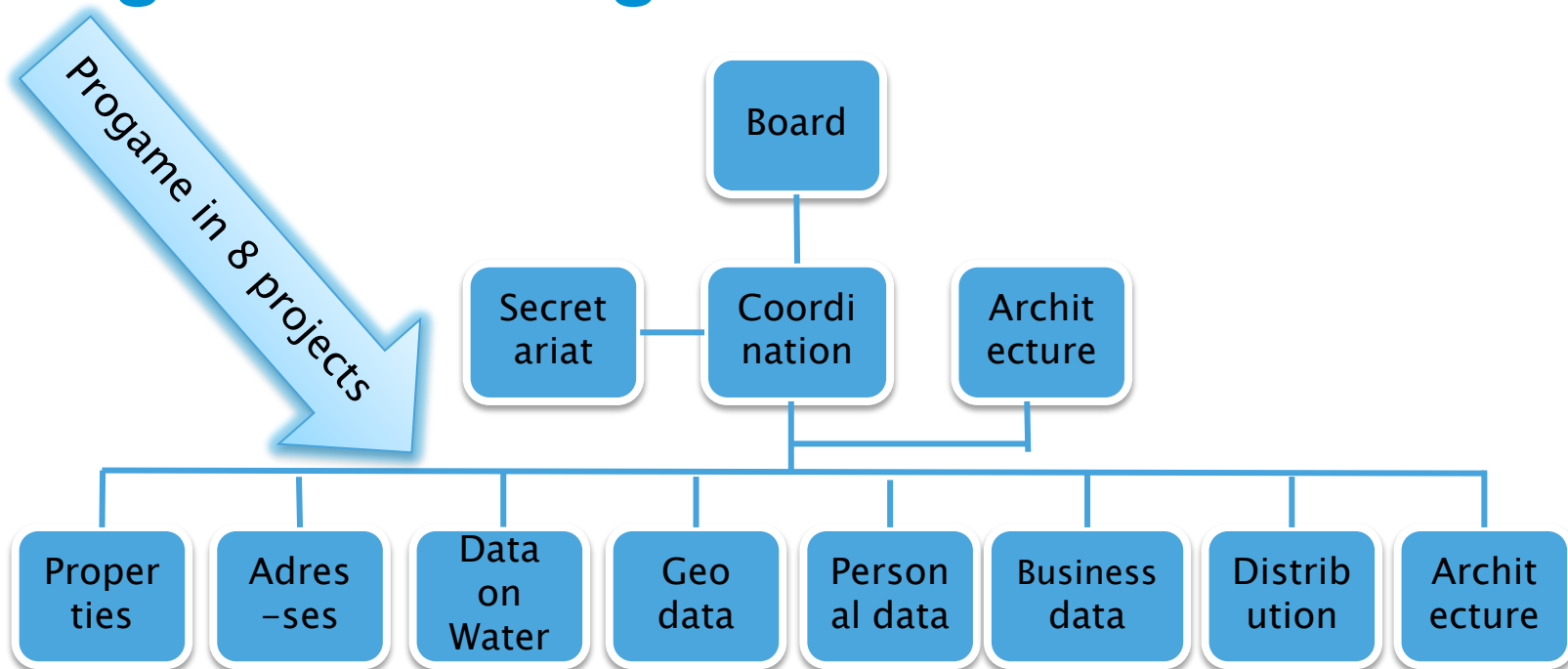


Network of Basic Registrations

Fewer systems for updating

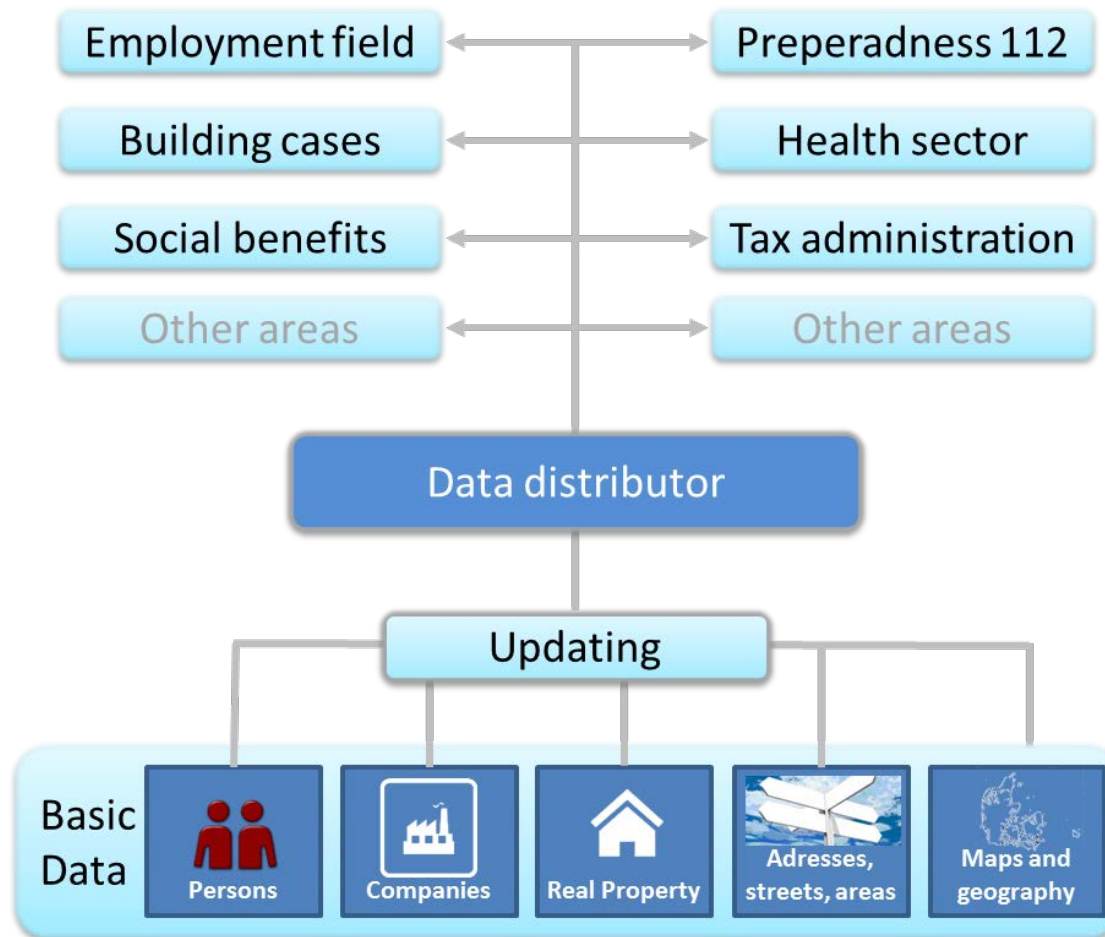
- Training of employees in municipalities

Self-registration

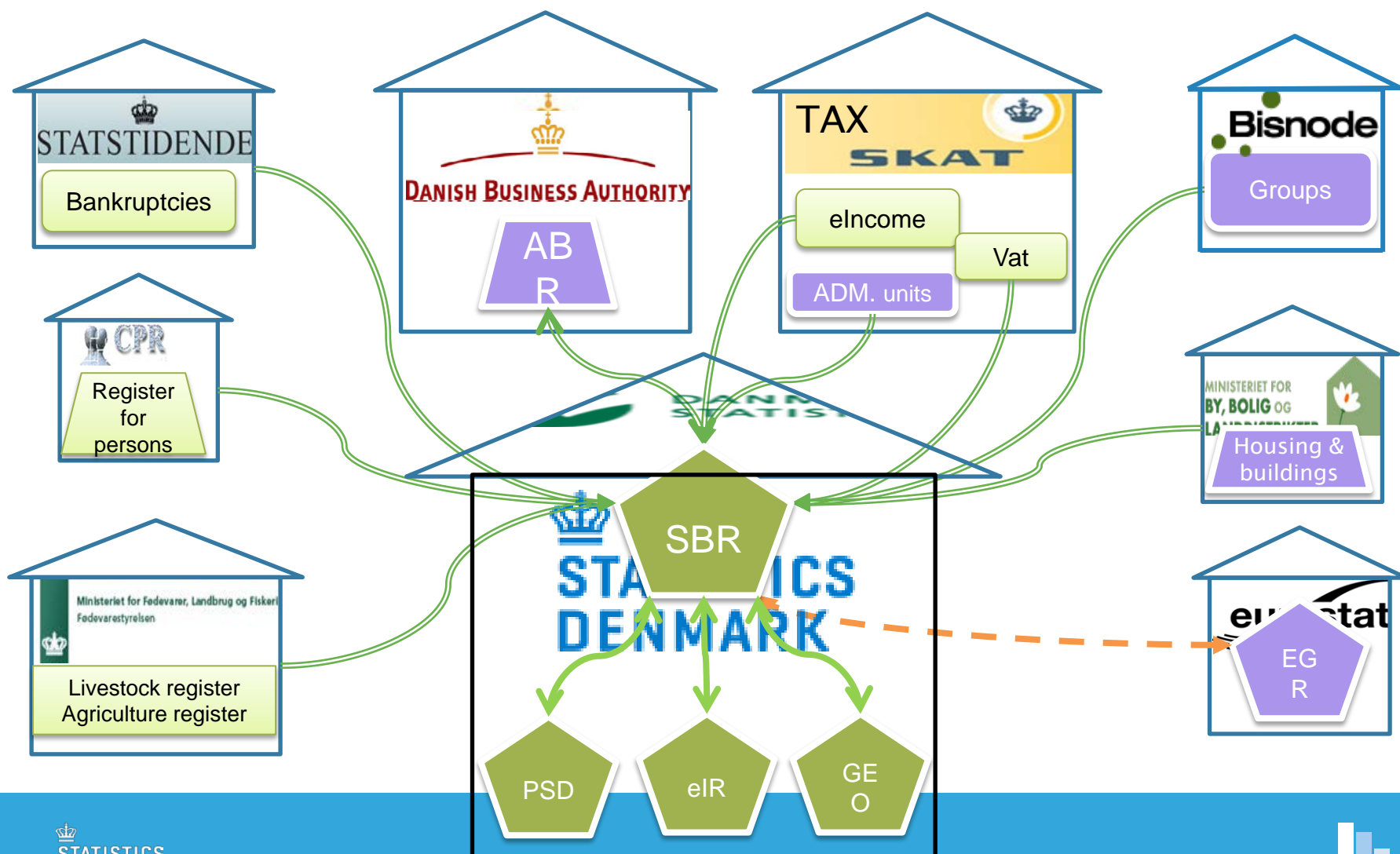
