



National profiling - manual and automatic




Relation between National Business Register and (enterprise) Group Register

■ $\frac{Turnover(B)}{Turnover(A) + Turnover(B)} < L(0.1)$


NACE(B) in (70, 64, 68, 49, 52, 82...)

nace code




Preliminary Findings – number of legal units
