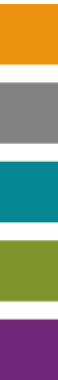

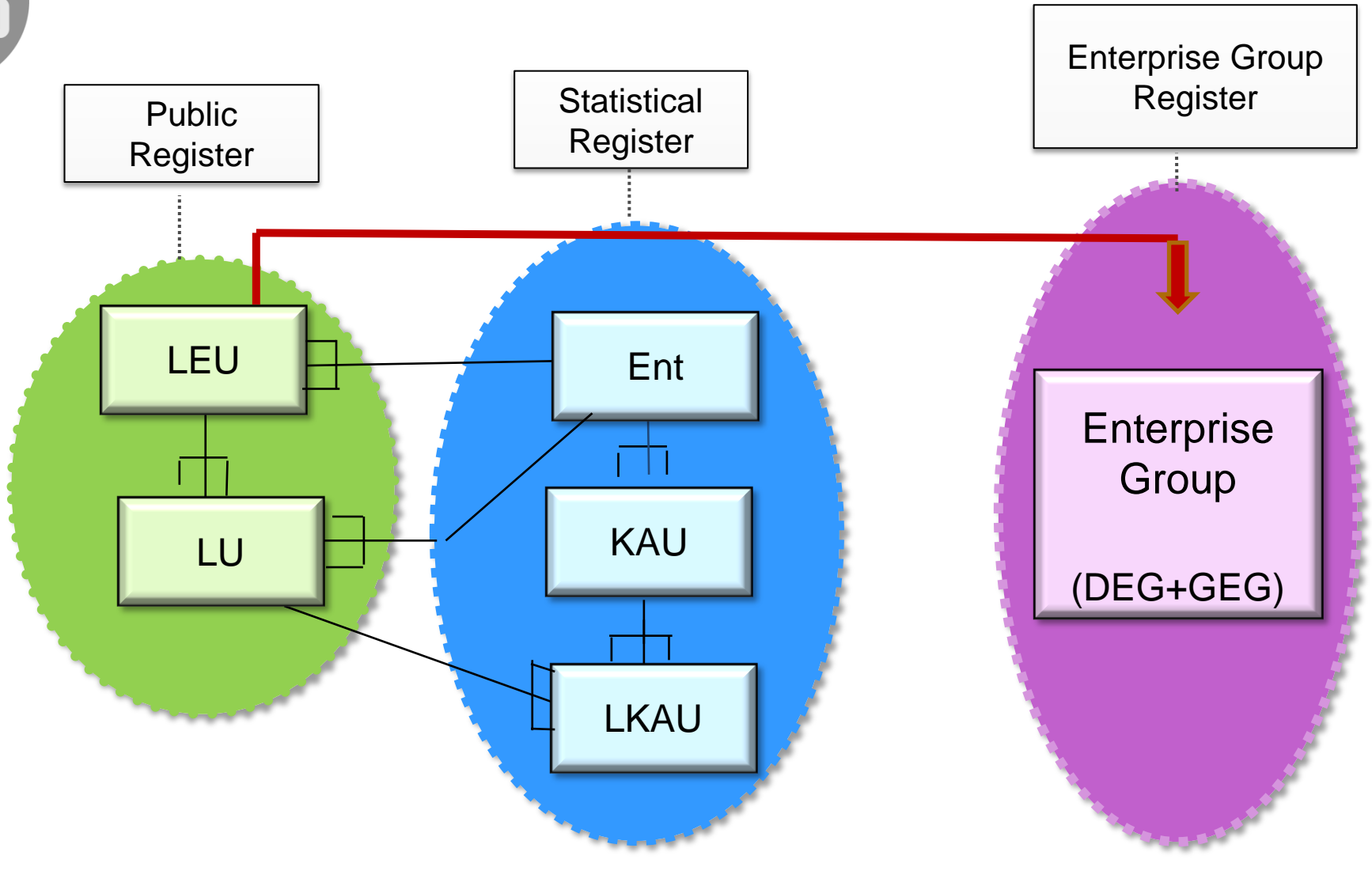




On-going developoment of national enterprise group register



Developing National Enterprise Group Register





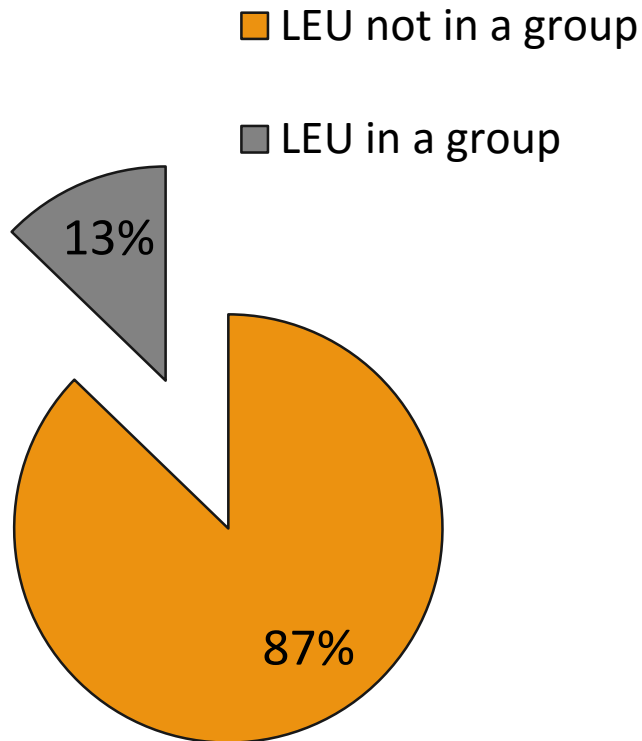
National profiling - manual and automatic



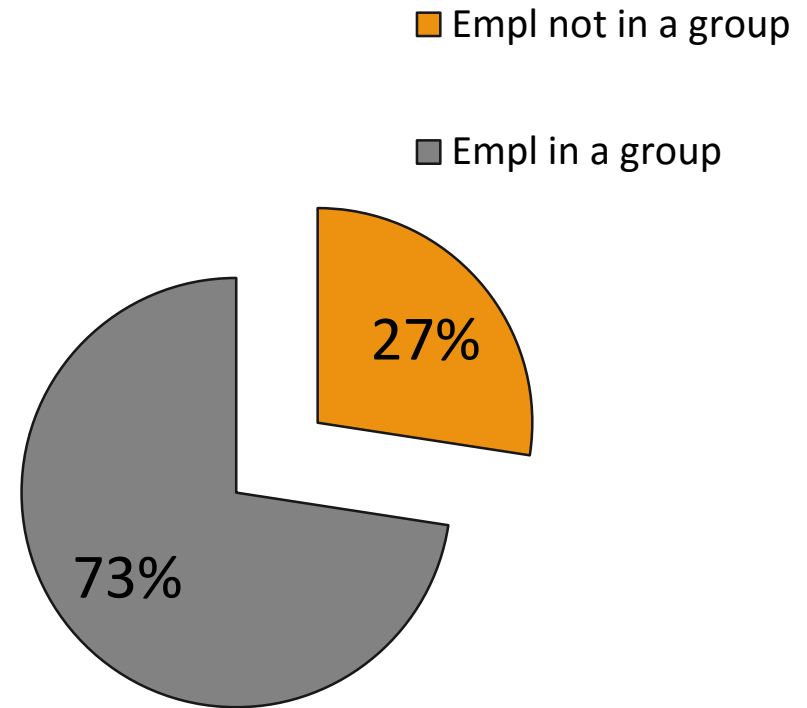
Relation between National Business Register and (enterprise) Group Register



Percentage of LEU

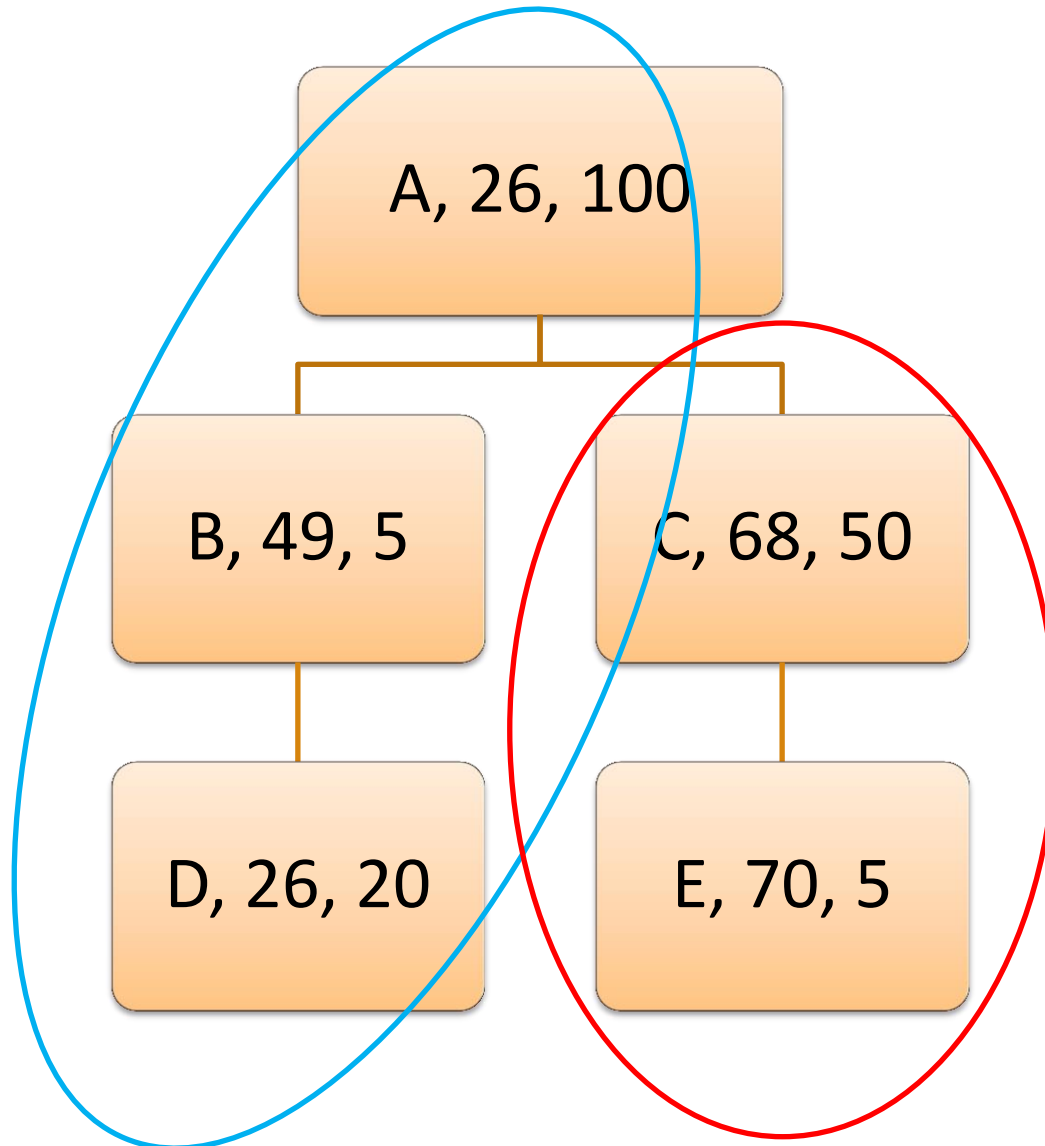

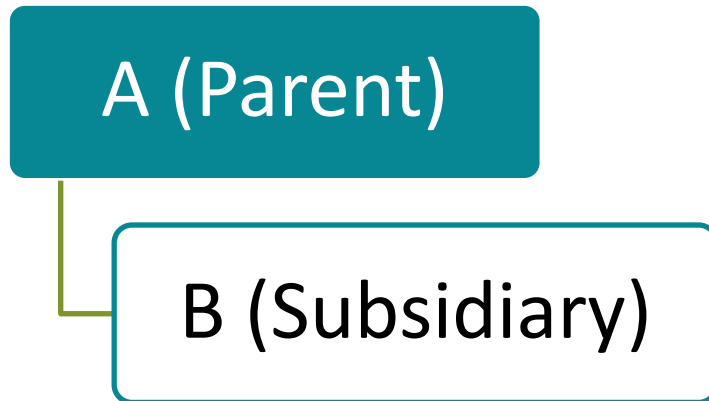




Enterprise group (ID, NACE, Turnover)



Ancillary activity



IF A controls B
(direct ownership)
and B is **relatively small**,
B is considered
ancillary
if it also has a
typically ancillary
nace code

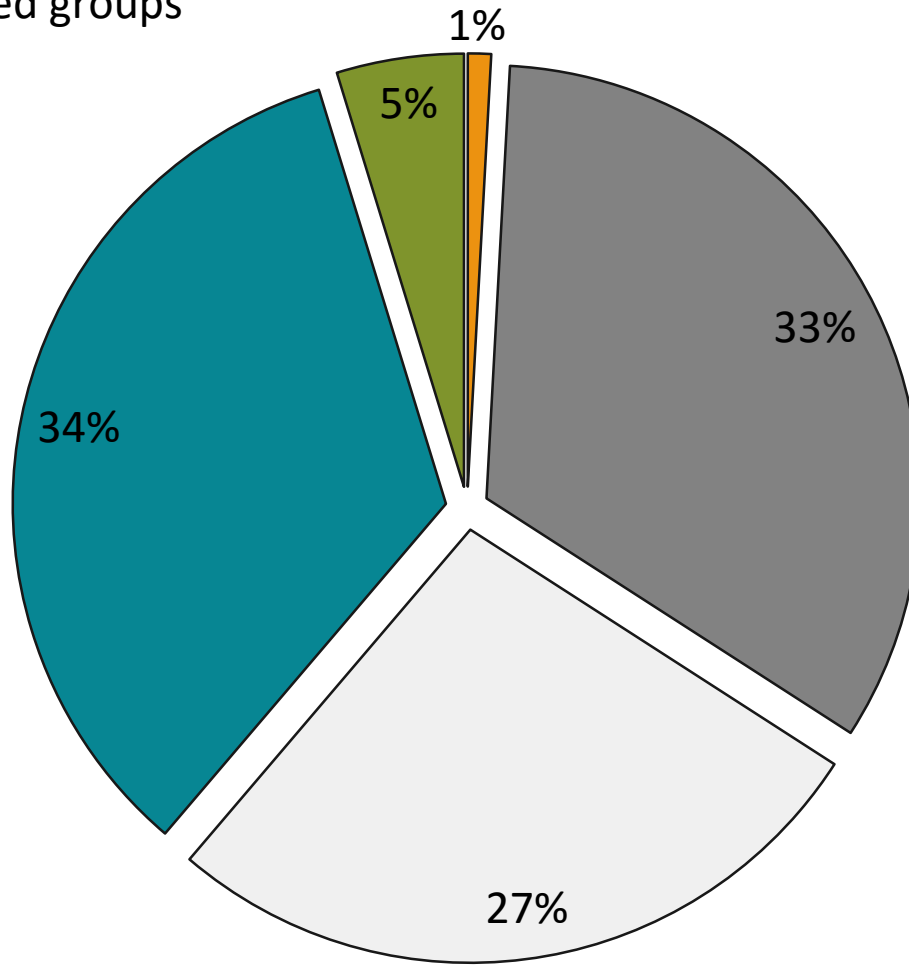
- $\frac{Turnover(B)}{Turnover(A)+Turnover(B)} < L (0.1)$
- NACE(B) in (70, 64, 68, 49, 52, 82...)





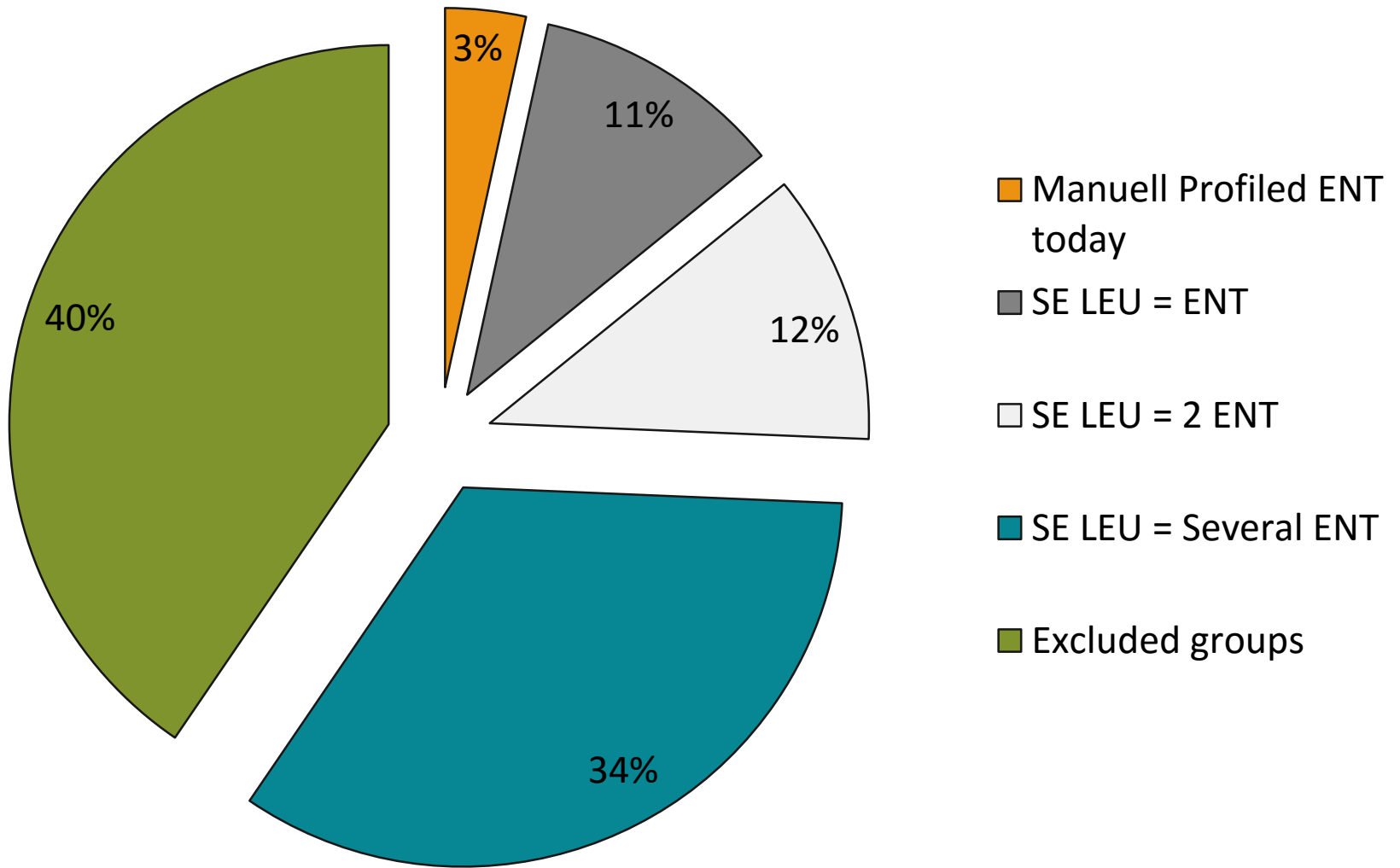
Preliminary Findings – number of legal units
