The 1st Dispatch of a Mission Team to CAPMAS in Egypt for "Developing Time Use Survey and Statistical Methods (Including SDGs Indicators) Using IT"

The SBJ dispatched the 1st mission team to the Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) in Egypt from June 9 to 21, 2022, as part of the country-focused training course on "Development of Time Use Survey and Statistical Methods (Including SDGs Indicators) Using IT" produced by the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). Since the program had been suspended for years due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the mission team conducted demand surveys and discussions regarding future training with CAPMAS. During the mission, a seminar was held to share information on the status of statistical surveys as well as challenges and future plans in both Egypt and Japan.

"Population Estimates" (Final estimates, Japan, January 1, 2022)

### [Total Population]

- The total population was 125,309 thousand, a decrease of 759 thousand (0.60%) from the previous year.
- The population under 15 years old was 14,718 thousand, a decrease of 265 thousand (1.77%) from the previous year.
- The population aged 15 to 64 was 74,375 thousand, a decrease of 658 thousand (0.88%) from the previous year.
- The population aged 65 and over was 36,215 thousand, an increase of 164 thousand (0.45%) from the previous year.

### [Japanese Population]

- The Japanese population was 122,638thousand, a decrease of 622 thousand (0.50%) from the previous year.

## [Total Population]

- The total population was 124.93 million, a decrease of 0.80 million (0.63%) from the previous year.

"Monthly Report on Internal Migration" (Japan, May 2022)

# [All nationalities]

- The number of internal migrants was 423,842, an increase of 66,049 (18.5%) from the previous year.
- The number of inter-prefectural migrants was 199,078, an increase of 36,521 (22.5%) from the previous year.

- The number of intra-prefectural migrants was 224,764, an increase of 29,528 (15.1%) from the previous year.

### [Japanese]

- The number of internal migrants was 365,625, an increase of 37,038 (11.3%) from the previous year.
- The number of inter-prefectural migrants was 166,267, an increase of 18,382 (12.4%) from the previous year.
- The number of intra-prefectural migrants was 199,358, an increase of 18,656 (10.3%) from the previous year.

- Number of persons working at the location of establishment: 29.23 million persons, down 0.1% over the year.

"Consumer Price Index" (Preliminary, 2020-base, Ku-area of Tokyo, June 2022)

- The consumer price index for Ku-area of Tokyo (preliminary) was 101.8 (2020=100), up 2.3% over the year before seasonal adjustment, and up 0.1% from the previous month on a seasonally adjusted basis.

"Labour Force Survey" (Basic Tabulation, Japan, May 2022)

- The number of employed persons was 67.30 million, an increase of 0.17 million from the previous year.
- The number of unemployed persons was 1.91 million, a decrease of 0.22 million from the previous year.
- The unemployment rate, seasonally adjusted, was 2.6%.

"Family Income and Expenditure Survey" (Two-or-more-person Households, Japan, May 2022) [Expenditures for Two-or-more-person Households]

- The average of monthly consumption expenditures per household was 287,687 yen, up 2.4% in nominal terms and down 0.5% in real terms from the previous year.

[Income and Expenditures for Workers' Households]

- The average of monthly income per household stood at 489,745 yen, up 0.1% in nominal terms and down 2.7% in real terms from the previous year.
- The average of consumption expenditures per household was 314,979 yen, down 0.9% in nominal terms and down 3.7% in real terms from the previous year.

"Survey of Household Economy" (Two-or-more-person Households, Japan, May 2022)

- Change over the year of monthly expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet [Average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet]
  - Average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet was 20,612 yen (up 19.3% in nominal terms).

[Main items contributed to the change of average expenditure on goods and services ordered over the internet]

- Travel-related costs: up 229.4% in nominal terms
- Food: up 14.7% in nominal terms
- Tickets: up 163.7% in nominal terms
- Insurance: up 19.6% in nominal terms
