

Map6. Persons Aged 15 and over with 'Secondary Economic Activity' per 100 population: Province, 2008



* Having Secondary Economically Active Rate, expressed in percentage, is the proportion of the persons having secondary economic activity in a given main activity status to the total number of persons in the corresponding main activity status.

3.3 SECONDARY ACTIVITY AND MAIN ACTIVITY

As previously mentioned, when a person was identified as a person having a 'Secondary economic activity', the type of his/her activity were ascertained, and then classified into 10 categories. In Table 3.4, those 10 categories are further lumped into 8 categories. There, category 'Unpaid crop/livestock farming' consists of 'Unpaid crop farming' and 'Unpaid livestock farming'. Category 'Paid crop/livestock farming' consists of 'Paid crop farming' and 'Paid livestock farming' of original category.

Table 3.4 shows main activity of population who aged 5 years and over by Secondary economic activity by urban/rural areas. About 52 percent of employed population in Cambodia (aged 5 years and over) has a 'Secondary economic activity' beside their main activity. For them, the most favored secondary activity is 'Unpaid crop/livestock farming' (80.4 percent). In other words, it is reasonably assumed that about 80 percent of the employed population who has a 'Secondary economic activity' engages in family enterprises with no payment.

The proportion of employed 'Paid crop/livestock farming' as a 'Secondary economic activity' is 6 percent. The proportion of the unemployed people having paid farming as a 'Secondary economic activity' is much higher than that of the people having any other kinds of main activity with a 'Secondary economic activity'. According to the definition on the Census, an unemployed person is recognized since he/she has been under unemployment for more than 6 months, and the unemployed person who answered a type of 'Secondary economic activity' during the Census are classified as having an experience of employment.

On one hand, there is a distinct urban-rural difference in the likelihood of having 'Secondary economic activity'. Rural people who aged 5 years and over are much more likely to have secondary economic activity than the urban counterparts. On the other, the pattern of distribution by secondary activity is not so different between urban and rural areas. In urban areas, 'Unpaid crop/livestock farming' accounts for most of secondary activities among the employed people. But the proportion is lower than that in rural areas (60.4 percent and 81.3 percent respectively). The proportion of having 'Trade' as a secondary activity in urban areas is higher than that of having any other secondary activities excluding 'Unpaid crop/livestock farming'.
