

Speech by Mr. Fumihiko NISHI,  
Chief Advisor of the Project,  
At the occasion of the Opening Ceremony of the Training Course of  
the Project on Improving Official Statistics in Cambodia

In Japan, I am a government official and work for Statistical Research and Training Institute. I come to Cambodia every three months as a chief advisor of this project. So, I now work for two Statistical Institutes in both Cambodia and Japan.

Mr. San Sy Than, Director General of NIS, Mr. Chikaraishi, Resident Representative of JICA Cambodia Office, and Director General of Statistics Bureau of Japan, have made great efforts for a long time in order to commence this project. This project is so far expected for two years from this August till August 2007. This statistical training is a main activity of this project, and consists of basic courses, intermediate courses, and advanced courses. As we all know, there is correlation between level of nation and quality of official statistics, because official statistics are often utilized for national policy making. Therefore, if you contribute to improve official statistics, Cambodia will be developed more quickly.
