

Introduction of the history of statistics in Japan


- ❖ The history of Japan's government statistic started with the establishment of the Statistics Division (Seihyo-ka), the predecessor of the Statistics Bureau of Japan, in the Central Chamber (Sei-in) of the pre-constitutional Meiji government (Dajokan) in 1871.
- ❖ The 150-year history of Japan's government statistic is introduced with panels and valuable historical materials.


■ Access by Subway

- Toei Oedo Line: 5 min. walk from "Wakamatsu-Kawada Station", Kawada exit.
- Tokyo Metro Tozai Line: 15 min. walk from "Waseda Station", 2 exit.
- Tokyo Metro Fukutoshin Line: 10 min. walk from "Higashi-Shinjuku Station", Elevator exit.

■ Access by Bus

- From JR Shin-Okubo Station or JR Okubo Station
 Get on the Toei Bus bound for "Shimbashi Station" or "Iidabashi Station" and get off at the "Kokuritsu-Kokusai-Iryo-Kenkyu Center" stop (approx. 10-min. ride).

7 Special exhibition booth




Exhibitions under specific themes are held and the results of statistical surveys are displayed in an easy-to-understand manner.
